
Transmitted herewith is Bill No. 759, which I have signed into law this date as Public Law 20-77.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Seven Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Dollars (\$785,000) Section 1. are appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency of Guam (the "Agency") to construct sewer lines at Bello Road, Barrigada. Three Million Five Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars Section 2. (\$3,545,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Agency to construct waterlines and reservoir in the Macheche area of Barrigada.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Seven Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Dollars (\$785,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the purpose of constructing sewer lines at Bello Road, Municipality of Barrigada.
- Section 2. Three Million Five Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$3,545,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the purpose of constructing waterlines and reservoir in Macheche/Barrigada Municipality of Barrigada.
- Section 3. The Barrigada Municipal Planning Council shall coordinate the sewer lines project authorized by this Act with the Public Utility Agency of Guam with its implementation. The contracting officer for the project shall be the Chief Officer of the Public Utility Agency of Guam.
- Section 4. The sum of One Hundred Sixty Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$160,600) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for infrastructure and village improvements and other purposes in the Municipality of Mangilao in the following amounts:

One Hundred Twenty Nine Thousand Dollars (\$129,000) for road (a) openings, road repairs and asphalt road paving to be determined by the Mangilao Municipal Planning Council; Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for junk bulky items collection; (b) Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) to install street names in Mangilao; (c) One Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$1,600) to install guardrails in (d) Mangilao to be determined by the Mangilao Municipal Planning Council; The sum of Thirty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$33,915) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Power Authority in the following manner: Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) for installation of power lines and (a) poles in the Adacao Area; Three Thousand Nine Hundred Fifteen dollars (\$3,915) for installation of streetlights in the Municipality of Mangilao to be determined by the Mangilao Municipal Planning Council. The sum of Two Hundred Ninety Seven Thousand (\$297,000) is Section 6. appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Parks & Recreation in the following amounts; The sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) for (a) upgrading the Latte Heights park and Pagat Park; The sum of Forty Seven Thousand Dollars (\$47,000) to install new (b) fencing on the existing baseball field. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) is hereby appropriated

from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works and Recreation for paving and

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#### COMMITTEE REPORT

#### BILL 759

"AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY AGENCY OF GUAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A SEWER LINE IN THE BELLO ROAD, MUNICIPALITY OF BARRIGADA AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE AND VILLAGE IMPROVEMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MANGILAO AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, TO DO PASS AS SUBSTITUTED."

A public hearing was conducted by the Committee on Ways and Means, on Wednesday, July 19, 1989 at 9:20 a.m. in the Legislative Session Hall. The hearing was chaired by Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez, Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means, also in attendance were, Senators Ted S. Nelson, Vice-Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means, and Don Parkinson.

#### BACKGROUND

Presently, PUAG has seven (7) water wells along the Bello Road area supplying water to central and southern districts on Guam. This limited water resource shall not be exposed to the potential contamination of raw sewage due to the lack of adequate maintenance.

PUAG is therefore, requesting funds for the construction of sewer lines to eliminate exposure to health, ecological and environmental hazards and also to accommodate future physical improvements of our island.

#### TESTIMONY

Attached is written testimony presented to the committee by the Deputy Director of PUAG, Mr. Felix Camacho, Mr. Anthony C. Blaz, was in attendance during the presentation.

Mr. Anthony C. Blaz stated the need for the construction of the sewer lines, for the protection of our health and environment. He also stated that PUAG engineers are preparing designs for a sewer system in the areas that are located above the aquifer. Senator Carl Gutierrez questioned

the status of projects recently approved by the legislature Mr. A. Blaz stated that PUAG engineers are preparing sewer system design in the BPM area in Mangilao, because the location of the Guam Community College, George Washington High School and residential customers demanding proper disposal system.

Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez requested that signs for proposed projects at construction site identify main sponsor of bill funding the project.

## COMMITTEE FINDINGS & ANALYSIS

The fiscal Note for Bill 759 is attached along with BBMR's comments that Seven Eighty Five Thousand Dollars (\$785,000) will further increase the deficit of appropriation vs revenues this fiscal year.

#### RECOMMENDATION

The committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill No. 759 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature with the following modifications:

1) That the title of the original Bill No. 759 includes infrastructure and village improvements in the Municipality of Mangilao; and the carnival ground in Agana and for other pruposes.

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2) That the amount of appropriations be increased by Four Million Ninety Six ThousandFive Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$4,096,515)

TESTIMONY ON BILLS 758, 759, and 760

ALL RELATING TO SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT.

Submitted by Anthony C. Blaz, Chief Officer Public Utility Agency of Guam July 19, 1989

Good morning, Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislative Comittee on Ways and Means. I am here today to testify in support of the following bills relating to wastewater infrastructure improvements in specific villages:

- 1. Bill 758 An Act to Appropriate the Sum of Nine Hundred Six Thousand One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$906,150) to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the Design and Construction of Sewer Lines Collector for Ordot-Chalan Pago Elementary School.
- 2. (Bill 7759) An Act to Appropriate the Sum of Seven Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Dollars to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the Purpose of Constructing a Sewer Line in Bello Road, Municipality of Barrigada.
- 3. Bill 760 An Act to Appropriate the Sum of One Million Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$1,870,000) to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the Design and Construction of Sewer Lines in the Municipality of Ordot-Chalan Pago.

The areas targeted for sewer infrastructure improvements are moderately dense residential areas with no public sewage collection system. Sewage from the aforementioned elementary school and residences are being collected through individualized septic tank/leachfields. Like septic tank/leachfields in other areas of Guam, many are old and may not be properly maintained and operating at a desirable efficiency level. As a result, residents are being exposed to

possible health and environmental hazards from improperly disposed sewage. Of extreme concern is the high volume of sewage being discharged from the public school.

Presently, PUAG has existing wells located in and around the proposed sewer improvement areas mentioned in the above bills; and these areas are located on top of our precious aquifer. Any contamination of these water resources will force the government to abondon the affected wells, and result in a substantial decrease in the water supply for central and southern Guam.

The installation of sewer lines will provide a reliable public sewage collection system that would eliminate overflows and improper treatment of raw sewage from septic tanks that may not be properly maintained. As a result, risk of exposure to health, ecological and environmental hazards will be minimized if not totally eliminated. In addition, the risk of contaminating our valuable underground water resources in these districts will greatly be reduced.

We are very pleased to see bills such as these introduced by the Legislature. We strongly support such initiatives which would provide financing for water and wastewater infrastructure improvements and facilitate better service to our residents.

The passage of these bills will provide adequate wastewater infrastructure to not only accommodate the school and existing residences, but also future developments in the areas. The added public sewage collector systems will not only improve the health and environmental conditions of the impacted areas, but will also generate additional revenue for PUAG through expanded sewer services.
