#### PREFACE:

The Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred Bill No. 830, "An act to appropriate the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) to the Government Claims Fund," conducted a public hearing on Tuesday, July 25, 1989 at 10:30 a.m. in the Legislative Session Hall. [Attachment 2]

Committee members present were Senator Ted S. Nelson, Acting Chairman, Committee on Wavs and Means. Also present were Senators John P. Aguon, Elizabeth P. Arriola, Pilar C. Lujan, Doris F. Brooks, Martha C. Ruth, Tommy V.C. Tanaka and Ernesto Espaldon.

#### NOTIFICATION:

Letters of notification [Attachment 3] were sent to: the Governor; the Director, Bureau of Budget and Management Research; to the Director, Department of Administration; the Attorney General; the Committee members and to the general public, and the newsmedia.

#### TESTIMONY:

Appearing before the Committee was Mr. Michael J. Reidy, Director, Bureau of Budget and Management Research. Mr. Reidy informed the Committee that the Administration supports Bill No. 830 and also reminded the members that the provisions of Bill No. 830 were originally incorporated into the Fiscal Year 1990 Budget Act.

There being no further witnesses, the Chairman, adjourned the Committee hearing on Bill No. 830.

At this point, the Chairman instructed the Committee staff to prepare a report for review by the Committee.

#### COMMITTEE FINDINGS:

The Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred Bill No. 830, finds that:

- 1. The passage and enactment of the appropriations contained in Bill No. 830 is supported by the Administration.
- 2. The Committee on Ways and Means having conducted the necessary hearings, hereby recommends that the Legislature favorably act on Substitute Bill No. 830.
