COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE REPORT Bill No. 834

The Committee on Ways and Means chaired by Acting Chairman Ted Nelson conducted a public hearing on Tuesday, July 25, 1989 at 9:00 a.m. at the Legislative Session Hall to hear testimony on Bill No. 834. Bill No. 834 is "An Act to Appropriate the Sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) from the General Fund to the University of Guam for the Maintenance and upkeep of the Fieldhouse". In attendance were Senators John Aguon, Elizabeth Arriola, Pilar Lujan, Doris Brooks, Ernesto Espaldon, and Martha Ruth. The University was represented by Acting President Roy Tsuda, George J. Viegas and Robert Pelkey.

University of Guam Acting President Roy Tsuda presented written testimony which he read. (See Exhibit A). He stated that UOG supports the intent of the bill which will provide \$100,000 to maintain and upkeep the Fieldhouse. He added that funds generated from contracts and users of the Fieldhouse do not support the maintenance and upkeep of the Fieldhouse. This appropriation measure will address the day to day maintenance, supplies, repair of sports equipment, air conditioning, lights, fans and for utilities. Dr. Tsuda added that UOG's operation budget does not include the Fieldhouse. This appropriation will provide the needed funds to operate the Fieldhouse for 1990. The fieldhouse budget for maintenance and personnel needs will be assumed in the future in the UOG budget and additional three (3) new FTE's will be requested to handle the operation of the Fieldhouse. In the meantime, the appropriation will be used for the 1990 operation of the fieldhouse.

Senator Aguon requested that UOG provide a detailed breakdown of how the money is to be expended. Senators queried UOG's position on how they can be more accommodating to other government agencies. If this appropriation was to be made, will UOG be able to waive rental fees for government agencies who will use the facilities? For example, DOE's George Washington High School's graduation ceremony was held there and was charged the full rental price of \$1500. Senators were in agreement that the such appropriation will subsidize the fieldhouse to allow fee waivers for government agencies. UOG responded that they have fee schedules for government agencies and also waive fees for specific events. However, they will be looking into this matter to allow government agencies to use of the fieldhouse at no cost.

COMMITTEE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee finds that the UOG Fieldhouse is in need of such appropriation. An additional six thousand is needed to cover personnel needs thus changing the appropriation to \$106,000. The appropriation request will make a substantial impact in the operation of the fieldhouse facility.

The Committee recommends that Bill 834 be further substituted and that this bill be reported favorably for passage to the whole legislature.

Dear Senator Gutierrez:

The University of Guam strongly supports the intent and content of Bill 834 relative to the appropriation of \$100,000 from the General Fund to the University of Guam for the maintenance and upkeep of the Field House. Funds generated from contracts with users of the Field House simply cannot support the maintenance and upkeep of the Field House.

The estimated cost breakdown to perform the maintenance and upkeep needs of the Field House for FY 1990 is as follows, and includes some items of deferred maintenance which have not been addressed for lack of funds.

All of the above individuals would be employees under the Plant Management Division of the University of Guam. Two additional employees (1 building custodian and 1 maintenance worker) will be hired. The University's Plant Management unit will have the man-power and expertise to maintain the Field House. These two positions will be included in the University's budget request for FY1991.

B. Field House Revenue

The actual revenue from the Field House during the past 12 months (August 1, 1988 to July 25, 1989) was \$89,571. Thus, the revenue of \$72,089 for 10 months (ending May 31, 1989) on the "mystery" sheet which appeared in the Legislative Session Hall was accurate. The attached FY90 Auxiliary Services Budget Plan shows the staffing pattern of the Field House (outside of maintenance). All \$54,470 is funded via the revenues. The position entitled "Technical Assistant" is a formal unclassified position allowable under the University's Personnel Rules & Regulations.

I will be pleased to obtain the answers to any other questions you may have. I have clearly noted Senator John P. Aguon's concern in the use of provisional employees.
