AMEND §63201 ACT TO AND PARAGRAPHS (a), (b), AND (c) ALL OF TITLE 10 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, PERTAINING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF THE NATIONAL GUARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF 1 2 **GUAM**: Section 1. §63201 and Paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) all of Title 3 10, Guam Code Annotated are hereby amended to read as follows: 4 "§63201. The Adjutant General. The Adjutant general 5 shall be appointed by the [President] Governor and shall 6 have such rank and qualifications as the [President] 7 **Governor** may prescribe, and he shall: 8 9 [If nominated to the President by the Governor, b] Be capable of being Federally recognized in 10 accordance with Federal law and Army and Air Force 1 1 regulations, as appropriate, in the grade of at least 1 2 colonel: 1 3 Be promoted in the Guam Army or Air 14 (b) 15 National Guard, as appropriate, at the discretion of the Commander-in-Chief, to a grade not to exceed major 16 general; [, if eligible for federal recognition in such 1 7

grade, and shall then be recommended to the 1 President of the United States for promotion;] 2 Serve until such time as his replacement is 3 appointed by the [President] Governor or until he 4 5

resigns. The Governor may [recommend to the President the relieve [of] the Adjutant General for malfeasance, misfeasance or his inability to continue

Federally recognized status;"
