AN ACT TO AMEND §63201 AND
PARAGRAPHS (a), (b), AND (c) ALL OF
TITLE 10 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
PERTAINING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF
THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF THE
NATIONAL GUARD.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF
2 GUAM:

3 Section 1. §63201 and Paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) all of Title
4 10, Guam Code Annotated are hereby amended to read as follows:

5 "§63201. The Adjutant General. The Adjutant general
6 shall be appointed by the [President] **Governor** and shall
7 have such rank and qualifications as the [President]
8 **Governor** may prescribe, and he shall:

9 (a) [If nominated to the President by the
10 Governor, b] **Be** capable of being Federally recognized in
11 accordance with Federal law and Army and Air Force
12 regulations, as appropriate, in the grade of at least
13 colonel;

14 (b) Be promoted in the Guam Army or Air
15 National Guard, as appropriate, at the discretion of the
16 Commander-in-Chief, to a grade not to exceed major
17 general; [, if eligible for federal recognition in such

1 grade, and shall then be recommended to the
2 President of the United States for promotion;]

3 (c) Serve until such time as his replacement is
4 appointed by the [President] **Governor** or until he
5 resigns. The Governor may [recommend to the
6 President the] relieve [of] the Adjutant General for
7 malfeasance, misfeasance or his inability to continue
8 Federally recognized status;"
