PREFACE

The Committee on Youth, Senior Citizens and Cultural Affairs publicly heard Bill No. 267 on April 18, 1991, in the Public Hearing Room, Pacific Arcade Building, Agana. In attendance at that time were Chairperson, Senator Elizabeth P. Arriola and Senators Frank R. Santos, Marilyn D. Manibusan and Anthony C. Blaz.

TESTIMONY

The Committee received written tstinmony from Mr. Lee Webber, father of the late Robbie Webber. In his testimony, Mr. Webber thanked the Legislature in proposing to name the soccer field in memory of Robbie. He told the Committee that his son loved to play the game of soccer and he "always played to win while at the same time making sure that sportmanship was held high."

I would like to begin by thanking you for affording me the opportunity to testify on bill #267, an act to commend the Robbie Webber Youth Soccer League and to change the name of the Dededo soccer field to the Robbie Webber Memorial Soccer Field.

The Robbie Webber Youth Soccer League is prospering with around 400 young children learning the game of soccer. At the same time, they are having fun and learning what fair play and sportsmanship are all about.

It is both ironic and very appropriate that the hearing is being held today. For today is exactly one year to the day that my Robbie was buried.

Robbie loved the game of soccer. He always played to win while at the same time, making sure that sportsmanship was held high.

I'm not really sure if Robbie could have defined sportsmanship for you in words. But, his actions spoke louder than words.

I remember the time that he was dribbling the ball down-field and ran into, and knocked down, another player. He was so concerned with the other child's well being that he stopped to help him up. After helping him up, he continued his play.

Or, the numerous times he was hurt while playing goalkeeper only to bounce back (albeit limping) to finish his game. He was never a quitter and the other children knew him for his enthusiasm.

I thank you for your consideration in proposing to name the soccer field in memory of my Robbie. I only wish he were here today to play on it.
