COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE REPORT

BILL NO. 181

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS.

PURPOSE AND ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS

Bill No. 181 is a simple appropriation Bill for \$50,000 to the Office of Veterans Affairs for disabled American Veterans transportation services.

PUBLIC HEARING

The Committee on Ways and Means conducted a public hearing on Tuesday, July 9, 1991 at 8:15 a.m. in the Legislative Public Hearing Room to gather testimony on Bill No. 181. Present at the hearing were Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez, Chairman of the Committee conducting the hearing, being joined by Senators Anthony C. Blaz, Michael J. Reidy, David L.G. Shimizu, Elizabeth P. Arriola, J. George Bamba, and Doris F. Brooks.

TESTIMONY

The Chairman called for testimony on Bill No. 181, however, no one appeared to testify either for or against the Bill. Additionally, no written testimony was submitted.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways and Means, considering the subject matter of the Bill which is to provide transportation for disabled veterans, seeing a need for this appropriation, recommends that Bill 181 be reported out to the full Legislature to Do Pass as Introduced.
