Report On Bill 461

Bill 461—An act to amend 16 GCA Section 7129 (a) to provide that license plates shall be displayed on the front of motor vehicles.

Preface

The Committee on Judiciary and Criminal Justice convened for a public hearing on November 12, 1991 at 10:15 a.m. in the Legislative Public Hearing Room to receive testimony on Bill 461.

Present alongside Committee Chairwoman Pilar C. Lujan was Vice-Chairman Francisco R. Santos and member Anthony C. Blaz.

Bill 461 was introduced by Committee Chairwoman Pilar C. Lujan.

<u>Overview</u>

In recent years, confusion has set in over whether or not licensed vehicles are required to have a license plate attached to the front of their vehicles.

In many instances, motorists have been pulled over and cited by police officials for not displaying a license plate on both the front and rear of their vehicles.

Under existing law, in the motor vehicle code, motorists are issued two plates but required only to attach a plate to the rear of their vehicles. The law is silent with respect to attaching a license plate to the front of vehicles.

At the request of the Guam Police Department, Bill 461 was introduced to ensure additional safety for police officers who pull over motorists and approach such vehicles for probable cause of a violation and for obvious identification purposes.

Testimony

Compiler of Laws Charles Troutman testified in favor of the measure and noted the quirk in the existing vehicle code.

Committee Findings & Recommendations

Since the Department of Revenue and Taxation issues motorists two license plates upon registration, the Committee believes that the intent of the existing law was to require display of such plates on the front and rear of a vehicle.

Moreover, the Committee concurs with the necessity to ensure additional protection for police officers who are out on patrol and occasionally identify a vehicle from its front end.

The Committee therefore recommends passage of Bill 384.
