BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Authorizing sale. The Governor is authorized to sell that 1 portion of Lot 5223-7, Unagauan, Barrigada, containing an area of 200± 2 square meters, consisting of a pre-war bullcart trail on the eastern boundary, 3 to Concepcion Pablo, owner of contiguous Lot No. 5221-2, Municipality of 4 Barrigada. The sale price shall be Six Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty 5 Dollars (\$6,750), which price is the average of two (2) recent fair market 6 appraisals. 7 Section 2. Proceeds. The proceeds of this transaction shall be given to 8 the Chamorro Land Trust Commission. 9

### I. OVERVIEW

## II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY



## Mr. Joaquin Acfalle

I recall for the longest time that Tan Chong Pablo has been attempting to purchase approximately 200 square meters of an old Bull Cart Trail adjoining her property on the east and as I know that the Bull Cart Trail is there without serving any purpose and will not land lock anyone if it is sold to Tan Chong, I am fully supporting the sale of the Trail to her. By doing so, Tan Chong can enhance development of her land

This matter could have been settled earlier had we have the authority but to sell the said Bull Cart Trail, we need to be authorized by law and I am recommending passage of Bill 506.

## Findings and Recommendations



The Committee on Housing and Community Development finds that by selling the Bull Cart Trail to Concepcion Pablo would not landlock anyone, the said Bull Cart Trail is there without serving any purpose. The committee recommends that the proceeds of the sale be given to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission. Members of the committee express their support.
