Dear Mr. Speaker:

Enclosed herewith is Substitute Bill No. 255 which I have signed into law this date as Public Law 22-93.

I have signed this measure because I do not think that it is appropriate to interfere with decisions affecting the operation of a co-equal branch of government.

However, the Director of the Library has expressed her concern about the change in the policy of having these records placed at the Library. (See Public Law 17-38.) She reports that these records are often sought by persons doing research. Placing these records at the GSA warehouse makes them far less accessible to the public.

Regardless of their placement, the Executive Branch stands ready to accommodate the Legislature's needs.
