The appraisal shall be conducted by two (2) independent appraisers licensed to do business in Guam. The average of the two (2) appraisals shall be utilized as the values for the basis of the exchange which is to be based on fair market value.
- (b) No prohibition against building. Nothing contained in this Act shall be construed to prevent or prohibit Dolores G. Mata from improving the land she receives or from building, erecting or constructing structures thereon in accordance with the building and zoning laws of Guam.

Enclosed herewith is Substitute Bill No. 462 which I have wetoed in its entirety.

Very little public land remains available for land exchanges. Public Law 22-18 the Legislature reserved only 70 acres of Lot No. 10120-R216 in Dededo for land exchanges. It is true that the lot contains approximately 535 acres but of that 60 acres was transferred to the Department of Public Works for a rock quarry, 20 acres was reserved for a cultural center and the remaining 385 acres was transferred to the Chamorro Land Trust.

The limited land that is available must be used for exchanges in which a public purpose is manifested. This is especially true in light of the enactment of Public Law 22-73 which grants land exchange as an option for claimants who prove that land was taken from them by the government without compensation.

Bill No. 462 authorizes the exchange of a lot in Geus, Merizo for a parcel in Dededo. However, there is no public purpose served by the exchange. The private property is not being used for a public purpose. The private property is not needed for a public use.

There are many parcels on Guam that are difficult to use. Nevertheless, the government cannot assume ownership of them just to assist the owners. In this particular case the government may be able to find an easement and create access to this property.

We have a duty to protect our limited public resources and this measure calls for the needless grant of such resources.

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Housing and Community Development scheduled a Public Hearing on October 18, 1993 at 9:00 a.m. in the Legislative Public Hearing Room, Temporary Legislative Building, Agana, Guam.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Mr. Fred Camacho

Mr. Camacho said that the property is located within a wetland area. He asked the Committee members to support Bill No. 462.

Mr. Ray Acfalle

Mr. Acfalle expressed the Department's support for Bill No. 432, although he says that the government Lot to be exchanged (10104-1, Dededo) should be Lot No. 10120-R16, Dededo, which was reserved by P.L. 22-18 for land exchanges.

III. Findings and Recommendations

The Committee finds that Lot No. 432, is in fact landlocked, and that about half of the property would be submerged under water in the event of heavy rains. The committee also finds that Lot No. 10104-1, Dededo should be amended to read 10120-R16.

The Committee Housing and Community Development to which was referred Bill no. 462 "An Act to Authorize the Governor to Exchange Lot No. 432, Merizo, for a portion of Lot No. 10120-R16, Dededo." as amended by the Committee on Housing and Community Development, does hereby submit its recommendation to the Twenty-Second Guam Legislature "TO DO PASS" BILL 462.

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



AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO EXCHANGE LOT NO. 432, MERIZO, FOR A PORTION OF GOVERNMENT LOT NO. 10104-1, DEDEDO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. (a) Background. Ms. Dolores G. Mata, the owner of Lot No.
- 3 432, Geus, Merizo, through which the Geus River flows, has been having
- 4 difficulty obtaining building permits to build a residence on this lot.
- 5 Although some portion of the higher ground may not be subject to
- 6 flooding, the lower portion of the lot is so subject. Additionally, the land is
- 7 landlocked and there is no access.
- 8 (b) Authorization for land exchange. The Governor is
- 9 authorized to exchange a portion of Lot No. 10104-1, containing an area of
- 10 14,433 ± square meters, Y-Seng Song, Municipality of Dededo, owned by
- 11 the government of Guam, for Lot No. 432 containing an area of 7,712±
- 12 square meters located in Geus, Merizo, Municipality of Merizo and owned
- 13 by Dolores G. Mata, as shown on Dwg. No. M71-070 made under
- 14 supervision of Juan R. Mesa RLS 20, Dated 5-17-51, filed under Land
- 15 Management Document No. 107882, on a value for value basis.
