## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. §3127 of Chapter 3 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is

"§3127. Customs and Quarantine Agency. There is hereby established within the government of Guam, the Customs and Quarantine Agency (the "Agency"). The Director of the Agency, who is the head of the Agency, shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the legislature. The senior ranking classified Customs and Quarantine Officer within the Agency shall act as the Deputy Director of the Agency with all the powers of such a deputy but without additional compensation. The compensation of the Director of the Agency and of such Director's personal secretary shall be set by the Civil Service Commission."

## I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Judiciary, Criminal Justice and Environmental Affairs scheduled a public hearing on March 7, 1995 at 9:30 a.m. at the Legislative Public Hearing Room. Public notice was announced on the March 6, 1995 issue of the PDN. Members present were:

## II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Mr. John Quinata, Acting Director for the Customs and Quarantine Agency, testified in support of the passage of Bill 129. He stated that the Bill's intent, which is to clarify that the senior ranking officer shall act as the Deputy Director of the Customs and Quarantine Agency, will only serve to bring the Agency closer towards the attainment of its goals and improvement of its service to the public.

## III. FINDING AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee finds that the Customs and Quarantine Agency needs a change in the manner in which the Deputy Director is determined. Currently, the Deputy Director of the Agency is determined by the senior classified employee of the Agency. The Committee finds that the Agency would be better served if the senior ranking employee acts as the Deputy Director of the Agency, based on the reasoning that the senior ranking employee should be more qualified than the senior classified employee.

Accordingly, the Committee on Judiciary, Criminal Justice and Environmental Affairs, to which was referred **Bill No. 129**, does hereby submit its findings and recommendation to the Twenty-Third Guam Legislature **TO DO PASS Bill No. 129** "AN ACT TO AMEND, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 3127, OF TITLE 5 GCA, RELATIVE TO DETERMINING THE SENIOR CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEE WITHIN THE CUSTOMS AND QUARANTINE AGENCY."
