AN ACT TO AMEND P.L. NO. 24-128, RELATIVE TO CORRECTING A TECHNICAL ERROR IN THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE SUBJECT LOT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Public Law Number 24-128 is hereby amended to read as

3 follows:

Since 1970, Edward T. Rios "Section 1. Legislative Findings. 1 has been occupying Lot Number 20, Extension of Block 27, in New Agat 2 Village, an area of approximately $880 \pm$ square meters. Mr. Rios filed his 3 application to purchase this property on January 28, 1980. The 4 government failed to expedite this sale and Mr. Rios still does not have 5 On April 26, 1988, the acting Director of the 6 title to the land. Department of Land Management recommended that the selling price 7 for Lot Number 20 be Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), 8 9 the same as similar lots sold by the government in the more developed areas of Pagachao or Pigua. Since this lot has been continuously 10 11 occupied by Mr. Rios and his mother, Elvina Reyes Rios, for the past 12 twenty six (26) years or more, it is only appropriate that the government 13 complete the sale of this land to those whom they promised so many 14 years ago.

Section 2. Authorization to Sell. The Governor of Guam is
 authorized to sell government-owned real property described as Lot
 Number 20, Extension of Block 27, Municipality of Agat, containing an
 area of 880 ± square meters, as shown on Drawing Number C4-70T529,
 to Edward T. Rios and Elvina Reyes Rios for the sum of Two Thousand
 Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00).

21 Section 3. Terms and Conditions. The government of 22 Guam and the Rios family shall enter into a contractual agreement 23 relative to the sale of Lot Number 20, Extension of Block 27, wherein 24 applicable terms and conditions to govern the sale shall be formulated 25 by the Director of the Department of Land Management. The buyer is prohibited from selling, transferring, reassigning or in any way relinquishing title to said property for a period of ten (10) years after the completion or full consummation of the land sale authorized herein. The Director of the Department of Land Management shall ensure that all terms and conditions governing the sale are met by the buyer prior to transferring title to said property.

7 Section 4. Sale Proceeds to Go to Chamorro Land Trust
8 Commission. Proceeds from the sale approved by this Act shall be
9 transferred to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission to cover
10 administrative and operational expenses."
