AN ACT TO ADD §§43116, 43117 AND 43118 TO CHAPTER 43, DIVISION 4, PART 1 OF TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A TRAINING PROGRAM FOR MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, AND THE CREATION OF A BOARDS AND COMMISSION APPRECIATION DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. ILiheslaturan Guahan finds that there are no uniform training or briefing programs for members of government of Guam boards and commissions. Without training, new board and commission members may find it difficult to function effectively in the capacity of their appointments until such time that they acquire, through experience, the skills necessary to carry out their responsibilities. Liheslaturan Guahan further finds that the University of Guam, under the "Service" and "Instruction" components of its Land-grant university status, is the most practical place for the development and implementation of such a training program.

It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to make training available for members of government of Guam boards and commissions so that they can more effectively serve and fulfill their fiduciary responsibilities to the agencies they represent. It is also the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* that these civic-minded individuals be accorded their rightful recognition for their service to the people of Guam by officially setting aside one (1) day per year for such recognition.

Section 2. Section 43116 is hereby added to Chapter 43 of Division 4, Part 1 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

"Section 43116. Development of the Boards and Commissions
Training Program. The University of Guam shall, within six (6)
months of the receipt of funding for this Section, develop a training
program for members of government of Guam boards and

1	commissions. Such training programs shall include, but not be limited
2	to, parliamentary procedures, ethics, fiduciary responsibilities,
3	leadership and direction, personnel policy and government finance."
4	Section 3. Section 43117 is hereby added to Chapter 43 of Division 4,
5	Part 1 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:
6	"Section 43117. Boards and Commissions Training. The
7	University of Guam shall, beginning with calendar year 1999, conduct a
8	training program for members of government of Guam boards and
9	commissions developed under the provisions of §43116 of this Chapter.
10	Such training program shall be conducted at least twice per year. If
11	there are fewer than five (5) board members who wish to take a
12	scheduled course, the two-year requirement may be waived. The cost of
13	tuition for such training shall be the responsibility of the agency whose
14	board or commission, the member serves on."
15	Section 4. Section 43118 is hereby added to Chapter 43 of Division 4,
16	Part 1 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:
17	"Section 43118. Boards and Commissions Appreciation Day. I
18	Maga'lahen Guahan shall designate, preferably during the month or week
19	in which volunteers are recognized, one (1) day per year for recognition
20	and appreciation of individuals serving on all boards and
21	commissions."
22	Section 5. Appropriation for Board Member Training Program.
23	The sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) is appropriated from
24	the General Fund to the University of Guam for the development of a Board

- and Commission Members Training Program to include, but not limited to:
- 2 parliamentary procedures, ethics, fiduciary responsibilities, leadership and
- 3 direction, personnel policy and government finance.

Committee Report on Bill No. 563

"An act to add new §43116, §43117 and §43118 to Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the development and implementation of a training program for members of Boards and Commissions and the creation of a Boards and Commission Appreciation Day."

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, Government Reform and Federal Affairs held a public hearing on Friday, April 17, 1998 at 11 a.m. in the Session Hall of I Liheslaturan Guahan. Public Notice of the hearing was announced in the April 10th and 17th, 1998 issues of the Pacific Daily News.

Senators in attendance were:

There being no individuals present to testify on the bill, the Chairman declared the bill formally heard. The Chairman indicated that the Committee would accept any written testimony on this bill during the next few days. No written testimony was submitted after the public hearing.

II. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION


The Committee finds that there are no uniform training or briefing programs for members of government of Guam boards and commissions. Without training, new board and commission members may finds it difficult to function effectively in the capacity of their appointments until such time that they acquire, through experience, the skills and necessary to carry out their responsibilities. Fiscal Note on Bill No. 3 (LS)

The Bureau is unable to ascertain the financial impact of this Bill due to unavailability of information.

The General Fund revenues available for appropriation, as adopted in Public Law 24-59 is \$353,292,790 (includes \$7,600,000 Autonomous Agency Fund, \$7,000,000 Use Tax and \$36,000,000 in Section 30 funds). The appropriations for PY1998 in P.L. 24-59 is \$346,128,092 plus continuing appropriations for debt service of \$2,504,141 for a total appropriation against of \$348,632,234. Pursuant to P.L. 24-59, surplus FY1998 revenues available for appropriations is \$4.6M.

However, it should be noted that the expected combined collection from both the Autonomous Agency Fund and the Use Tax is only \$3.0M, a reduction of \$11.6M (\$14.6 - 3.0 = \$11.6). As such, \$341,739,919 in revenue less \$348,632,234 in appropriations leaves an expected shortfall of (\$6.892.315) as of P.L. 24-59.
