III. BACKGROUND ON BILL 578(COR):

Findings: Estimated repair and replacement work in the village of Santa Rita in the amount of \$75,000 is needed for guard rails, street signs and the mayor's office in addition to repair and mitigation work that may be funded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

SUMMARY OF 7 3TIMONIES:

Mayor San Miguel indicated the support of the Mayors' Council. Mayor Wesley assured the committee that the funds requested were nominal at best but will go a long way to getting the much needed work repairs started.
