Dear Speaker Unpingco:

Enclosed please find Substitute Bill No. 660 (COR), "AN ACT TO AMEND §68901(b) OF ARTICLE 9, CHAPTER 68, DIVISION 2 OF TITLE 21 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZED USE OF FUNDS GENERATED FROM LEASES ON THE DEDEDO BUFFER ZONE", which I have signed into law today as **Public Law No. 24-237**.

This legislation provides that money from leases for the Dededo Buffer Zone in Dededo be used by the villages of Dededo and Yigo according to the approval of the respective Municipal Planning Councils. Previously, the law restricted the use of the money to the upgrade and maintenance of sports and recreational facilities. The same proportion of use by the two villages -- 2/3 for Dededo and 1/3 for Yigo -- is maintained. This legislation will allow the village of Dededo to pay for support services needed for the Dededo flea market, operating on the Dededo Buffer Zone, as well as other needed village expenses. This legislation also provides that both the Municipalities of Dededo and Yigo will establish rules and regulations for the use of the funding.







**AN ACT TO AMEND §68901(b) OF ARTICLE 9,
CHAPTER 68, DIVISION 2 OF TITLE 21 OF THE
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
AUTHORIZED USE OF FUNDS GENERATED
FROM LEASES ON THE DEDEDO BUFFER ZONE.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

1 **Section 1.** Section 68901(b) of Article 9, Chapter 68, Division 2 of Title
2 21 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

3 **“Section 68901(b). Earmarking Proceeds for Dededo and**
4 **Yigo.** All proceeds from such leases shall be earmarked for the
5 exclusive use of the Dededo and Yigo Municipal Planning Councils
6 (two-thirds (2/3) to Dededo and one-third (1/3) to Yigo). Such funds
7 shall be spent by the respective Municipal Planning Councils for the
8 benefit of the municipality pursuant to rules and regulations governing
9 the use of such proceeds which are promulgated by the Municipal
10 Planning Council within one hundred eighty (180) days of passage of
11 this Act and adopted pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Law.
12 Prior to the adoption of such rules and regulations, the expenditure of
13 such proceeds shall be approved by the respective Municipal Planning
14 Council by majority vote. All proceeds under this Subsection (b) of
15 §68901 shall be deposited into the Dededo Municipal Planning Council
16 Fund.”
