AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONIES FROM THE THE TOURIST ATTRACTION **FUND** TO CHAMORRO HERITAGE INSTITUTE PLANNING RESEARCH, GROUP TO **FUND** THE DOCUMENTATION AND PUBLICATION OF A **OF DOCUMENTATION** COMPREHENSIVE CHAMORRO ARTISTIC EXPRESSIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Liheslaturan Guahan Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I finds, that when at all possible, every attempt must be taken to assist in the preservation of our Chamorro culture and heritage for the sake of our elderly, and more importantly, our younger generation. At the present time, our Chamorro culture and language is being taught to our children in the Guam public school system. I Liheslaturan Guahan also finds that another avenue of our Chamorro culture and heritage that must be preserved through documentation, are the various art forms of our ancestors.

Through documentation, it is the desire of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* that these publications manifest in vivid detail, the struggle for survival of the Chamorro culture and artistic expressions, and how the vibrant Chamorro people used to their advantage the resources available to them to persist in their own unique identity. It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* that the Chamorro Heritage Institute Planning Group undertake the responsibility of researching, documenting and publishing a comprehensive documentation of Chamorro artistic expressions.

Section 2. Appropriation. The sum of Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Tourist Attraction Fund to the Chamorro Heritage Institute Planning Group for the purpose of funding the research, documentation and publication of a comprehensive documentation of Chamorro artistic expressions.

Section 3. Planning and Coordination. The Executive Director for the Chamorro Heritage Institute Planning Group ("Director") shall be responsible
