
Enclosed please find Bill No. 561 (LS), "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION AND OUTFITTING OF A GYMNASIUM IN THE VILLAGE OF SANTA RITA", which I have signed into law as Public Law No. 24-302.

I ensured that funding for gymnasiums for every village on our island, including the village of Santa Rita, was included as far back as 1991 in Public Law No. 21-41. See attached relevant pages of this public law.

These appropriations were vetoed, although the situation allowing funding of these important recreational facilities was possible at that time. This is no longer the case for every village. Unfortunately, it will be misleading to indicate to the people of Santa Rita at this time that funding will be soon be found for a gymnasium in their village. The people of Santa Rita, however, are the beneficiaries of the new facilities of the Southern High School, which does contain recreational facilities.

I have reduced the appropriation amount at this time, due to lack of any available funding, however, the project is now projected into future planning.

Section 4. Appropriation. Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) are hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Institute.

Section 5. §§2913.13 and 2913.14 of Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, are repealed and a new §2913.13 is hereby enacted to read:

"§2913.13. Income limitations. The Federal Poverty Income Guidelines shall be used to determine income eligibility for the Medically Indigent Program. In the calculation of income, payments for medical insurance or medicare premiums shall be excluded from income. An individual found ineligible because of the income limitations set out in this §2913.13 prior to its repeal and re-enactment who was paying medical insurance or medicare premiums shall be reevaluated for eligibility from his or her time of application based on the new Guidelines."

AN ACT TO REENACT THE APPROPRIATIONS PROVIDED TO THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH IN FY 1991 TO MAKE THE SAME LEVEL OF APPROPRIATIONS AVAILABLE IN FY 1992, TO PROVIDE CERTAIN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS AS SPECIFIED, AND TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATIONS TO THE GUAM VISITORS BUREAU, THE GUAM MASS TRANSIT AUTHORITY, AND THE GUAM LEGISLATURE.

CHAPTER I. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

Section 1 ... Short Title. This Act may be known as the "Executive Branch Budget Act of 1992".

appropriation to the Legislature every six (6) months, until completed.

Section 37. Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for the architectural and engineering design and for the construction of a new Detention Facility at the Department of Corrections.

Section 38. Nine Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$9,200,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purposes of acquiring real property for the Ordot Landfill and for constructing a cover system at the Ordot Landfill.

Section 39. One Million Three Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$1,340,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for the architectural and engineering design and for construction of a new building and parking lot for the Motor Vehicle Division of the Department of Revenue and Taxation.

Section 40. Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority for the architectural and engineering design of the Skilled Nursing Facility.

Section 41. Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,200,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the renovation of the redesigned Northern District Sewage Treatment Plant, consisting of renovation and replacement of primary clarifiers, comminutor, pre-aeration tanks, centrifuge control panel, clarifier pump building, chlorination room, chlorine contact tanks and new chlorination line.

Section 42. One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$170,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Commission on Persons with Disabilities for personnel services and operations of the Commission for Fiscal Year 1992.

Section 43. [Sixteen Million Thirty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$16,032,000)] Zero Dollars (\$0) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to be allocated as follows to each village listed below for the purpose listed next to each village:

An appropriation for a gymnasium has already been made in previous law for the villages of Tamuning, Agana Heights, and Chalan Pago-Ordot. The Department of Public Works shall use the same design for all the gymnasiums to be built in the various villages of Guam as was used for the gymnasium in the village of Agana Heights.

Section 44. [Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000)] Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Umatac Municipal Planning Council for the Discovery Day Festivities. The Discovery Day Committee shall justify the expenses to the Umatac Municipal Planning Council.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Governor is authorized to allow the conduct of cockfights for the three (3) day weekend period consisting of Friday, Saturday, and Sunday for every annual village fiesta, for Discovery Day, and for Fiestan Tasi, with the net proceeds of such cockfights to be given to the Municipal Planning Council of the village in which the cockfight is held.

Section 45. Three Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-nine Dollars (\$369,839) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Health Planning and Development Agency for its Fiscal Year 1992 operations, to be allocated as follows:







**FINDINGS:**

Legislative Declaration, Findings and Intent. The Guam Legislature finds that it has been the goal and a priority of this Administration to see that every village has a gymnasium. The Guam Legislature, keeping in line with those goals, further finds that every child on Guam should have an opportunity to participate in sports and that each child should have access to adequate facilities, such as gymnasiums, to realize that opportunity. The Guam legislature further finds that building such facilities serves as a positive alternative for the youth of our island to develop their person, rather than the negative alternatives such as crime and drugs. The Guam Legislature finds that the immediate construction of gymnasiums and other sports facilities will go a long way in preserving the innocence of the youth of Guam and preserving the family unit.

**SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES:**

Mayor Joe Wesley of Santa Rita presented his Oral Testimony supporting Bill 561. With the Mayor of Santa Rita were a large number of residents of Santa Rita, predominantly youths. The message conveyed to the committee was very simple. The village of Santa Rita has been seriously neglected in the areas of community, senior, youth centers and is only thought of when all of the other villages have been accommodated as if Santa Rita is a stepchild.

The Mayor urgently recommended for the Guam Legislature to enact this very important legislation so that the youth of Santa Rita can be given a safe, secure and decent place to use for their recreation.

To demonstrate to the Senators how serious and urgent this matter is for the village of Santa Rita, the Mayor decided to invite some of the youth of Santa

Rita to witness this very important occasion where Bill 561 is being accorded its public hearing and for the youth of Santa Rita to voice their support for this gymnasium project and send the message themselves to the Senators of this Legislature..

**COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:**

The Committee, having conducted a sufficient hearing, does hereby recommend to the Legislature to do pass Bill 561, as substituted by the Committee on Finance and Taxation, "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$600,000.) **Section 1. Legislative Finding.** The Legislature finds that it has been the goal and a priority of this Administration to see that every village has a gymnasium. The Legislature, keeping in line with those goals, further finds that every child on Guam should have an opportunity to participate in sports and that each child should have access to adequate facilities, such as gymnasiums, to realize that opportunity. The Legislature further finds that building such facilities serves as a positive alternative for the youth of our island to develop their person, rather than the negative alternatives such as crime and drugs. The Legislature finds that the immediate construction of gymnasiums and other sports facilities will go a long way in preserving the innocence of the youth of Guam and preserving the family unit.

**Section 2. Appropriation.** The sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the

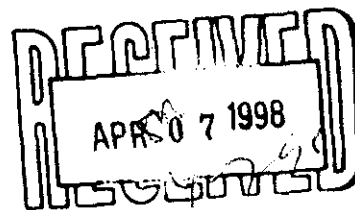
