### I. OVERVIEW

On June 23, 1997 the Committee on Rules, Government Reform and Federal Affairs conducted a public hearing on Bill No. 285 "An act to appropriate the sum of thirteen million three hundred and seventy-seven thousand dollars (\$13,377,000.00) from the General Fund for the operations of the Guam Legislature for Fiscal Year 1998." The hearing took place at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of the Guam Legislative Building. Public Notice was given through an announcement in the June 19, 1997 issue of the Pacific Daily News.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

There being no individuals present to testify on the bill, Senator Mark Forbes, the author of Bill 285, explained that the appropriation requested for the Guam Legislature is based on an annualization of the ten million dollars the Twenty-fourth Legislature has been operating on for the last three quarters, which is a reduction of two million dollars when compared to the previous Twenty-third Guam Legislature. Senator Forbes further stated that the Legislature would require no supplemental or additional appropriation, as all needs have been considered and the past six months has demonstrated that Guam Legislature can operate within this budget. Senator Forbes added that within this budget there is identified a small reserve to address issues such as lump sum payments.

#### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee finds that further examination of the legislative budget reveals that the Twenty-fourth Guam Legislature can operate on a budget lower that previous requested in Bill No. 285. An additional reduction of four hundred twenty seven thousand dollars (\$427,000.000) in *cost savings* can be realized by the Twenty-fourth Guam Legislature. Since the beginning of the Twenty-fourth Guam Legislature, measures have been taken to reduce the expenditures of the legislature including reducing the number of personnel in central operations, which has become the largest expense for the legislature. This translates into reducing the cost of government for the taxpayers of Guam and makes for a smaller, more efficient legislative branch.

The Committee further finds that operating at this budget will bring the budget of the Twenty-fourth Guam Legislature down to a level close to the Nineteenth Guam Legislature, much lower than the budgets for the two previous legislatures.

This reduced budget of twelve million nine hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$12,950,000.00) is reflected in Bill No. 285 as amended by the Committee.


