On behalf of the Municipality of Inarajan and Inarajan Municipal Planning Council we would like to thank you for your time and support in introducing Bill No. 364(LS).



**I. PUBLIC HEARING**

**BILL NO. 364 (LS)** was introduced on November 29, 1999 and referred to the Committee on Power, Public Works, Tax and Regulatory Reform, Municipal and Community Affairs (“PPWTRRM&CA”) on December 6, 1999. A Fiscal Note was requested from the Bureau of Budget and Management Research on December 7, 1999. As of December 17, 1999, PPWTRRM&CA has not received said Fiscal Note.

PPWTRRM&CA called a public hearing to order at 9:03 a.m., Monday, December 13, 1999 to hear testimony on **BILL NO. 364 (LS)**. The hearing was held in the Public Hearing Room of *l Liheslaturan Guåhan* in Hagåtña. Notices were placed in the *Guam Variety News and Views* and the *Pacific Daily News* on December 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup>.

The hearing was called to order by Senator Eddie Baza Calvo, Chairman of PPWTRRM&CA, with Committee Member, Senator Eulogio C. Bermudes, in attendance.

**II. TESTIMONY**

**Mayor Jesse L.G. Perez**, Municipality of Inarajan, presented oral and written testimony in support of the measure. He stated that the decision to temporarily relocate the Inarajan Mayor’s Office to the Malojloj Parish Social Hall was due to several factors, some of which included: the severe damage the office sustained during Typhoon Yuri as well as Typhoon Paka; the declaration by the Occupational Safety & Health Administration that the office was unsafe; and the failure of the office to meet the requirements set forth by the American’s With Disabilities (“ADA”) Act. He said that several vacant buildings were taken into consideration when the decision was made to move the Inarajan Mayor’s Office, and that the only one that met ADA requirements (within the village) was the Malojloj Parish Social Hall.

He stated that once the Inarajan Community Center is vacated and available, the Inarajan Mayor’s Office will relocate to said building. He explained that the manamko of the village are temporarily utilizing the Inarajan Community Center as their Senior Citizens’ Center, and it is expected that construction on a new Senior Citizens’ Center will be completed early next year. He requested that line 3 of Section 1 of the

measure be amended to correctly identify the Malojloj Parish Social Hall as the building that is currently being leased, and not the Inarajan Parish Social Hall. (Written testimony herein attached as "Exhibit A".)

**Senator Bermudes** inquired on the necessity of the appropriation. Mayor Perez said that during the budget process an oversight occurred which left the Inarajan Mayor's Office with a funding shortfall. Because of this, the office has had to tap into municipal funds in order to pay utility bills. He said that if appropriated, the \$32,000.00 amount will be used to cover the costs of the rent and utilities of the temporary Mayor's Office, and will also be used to pay for relocation costs once the office moves into the Inarajan Community Center.

There being no further testimony, the public hearing on Bill No. 364 (LS) concluded at 9:12 a.m.

### **III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATION**

At a time when limited resources have already placed constraints on the operations of the office of the Inarajan Mayor ("the office"), the Committee finds that the current shortfall that the office has encountered will further hamper operations. This would thereby create a situation wherein the office will be unable to effectively operate and meet the needs of the Inarajan community. The Committee also finds that the office of the Inarajan Mayor should not be put in a position where municipal funds must be used to make utility payments and/or rent because of an oversight that occurred during the budget process. The Committee further finds that the \$32,000.00 appropriation will more than adequately cover rent and utilities costs (for Fiscal Year 2000) while the temporary office is situated at the Malojloj Parish Social Hall. Moreover, it will also serve to assist in office relocation costs once the temporary Mayor's Office moves to the Inarajan Community Center. Therefore, the Committee reports out **SUBSTITUTE BILL NO. 364 (LS)**, to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, with the recommendation **TO DO PASS**.


