

Committee Report March 30, 2000

The Committee on Land, Agriculture, Military Affairs, & the Arts held a public hearing on March 30, 2000 at the Public Hearing Room at the Legislative Building. The hearing was called to order at 9:10 a.m. by the Chairman, Senator Marcel G. Camacho.

Bill No. 380(COR): AN ACT AUTHORIZING I MAGA'LAHEN GUAHAN TO EXCHANGE A PORTION OF LOT NUMBER 10119-11-R1, MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO, WITH LOT NUMBER 1332 NEW, MUNICIPALITY OF HAGATNA.

Summary of Testimonies:

Chairman Camacho deferred to Senator Salas, the main sponsor of the bill, for introductory comments and noted that both he and Speaker Unpingco were happy to co-sponsor the bill.

Senator Salas stated that when the judicial center was built, there was a need to acquire additional private property in the area. The properties were acquired through condemnation, but compensation was never completed. This is a case of one landowner attempting for the past four years to complete the compensation through a land exchange.

Robert Cruz testified that the land exchange will be advantageous to both the courts and Mr. Pangelinan. The courts would be able to develop up to 30 additional parking stalls, which are badly needed, because a shortage of parking has resulted in the courts utilizing overflow parking at the Agana Shopping Center. He stated that all surveys, appraisals, and title research has been completed, and that a value-for-value exchange is proposed.

Chairman Camacho noted that the bill did not mention that it was a value-for-value exchange, and that the bill would have to be amended to reflect this important point.

Mr. Cruz then added that the appraisal report, paid for by the courts, showed Mr. Pangelinan's property worth \$178,000 and the property in Dededo is worth \$110,000. Despite this, Mr. Pangelinan has agreed to the exchange, knowing that he is receiving the larger lot.

Senator Salas added that the problem has been ongoing for 8-10 years, and that Mr. Pangelinan wants to get this settled so that he can get his estate in order for his children.

Chairman Camacho then inquired about the ownership of the government property, and Mr. Cruz testified that it is under the courts control after having research done at DLM. The Chairman asked how Mr. Pangelinan acquired the entire 532 square meters, but Mr. Cruz could not answer the question. The Chairman gave closing comments that he understood the need for additional parking at the courts, and suggested that the courts consider a multi-level parking garage instead of just at-grade parking. He then stated for the record that Bill 380 had been publicly heard.

COMMITTEE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

Since its completion, the Guam Judicial Center has been in need of additional parking space. There is limited real estate in the immediate area available for this purpose. Mr. Pangelinan and the Superior Court have been negotiating for a land exchange for approximately ten (10) years.

Approximately four (4) years ago, the Court has offered Mr. Pangelinan a parcel in Dededo valued at One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000) to exchange with Mr. Pangelinan's parcel in Hagatna, valued at One Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Dollars (\$178,000). Mr. Pangelinan is aware that his parcel is more valuable than that offered by the Government. Mr. Pangelinan is willing to accept this discrepancy in value because he wants to put closure on this protracted transaction. The Committee feels that the land exchanges are based on the area and value of Mr. Pangelinan's property with the area and value of the Government's land.

The Committee on Land, Agriculture, Military Affairs and the Arts to which was referred Bill No. 380 (COR) wishes to report back its **recommendation** to **do pass** Bill No. 380 (COR) as substituted by the Committee.




Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guahan finds 2 that privately owned property located adjacent to the Guam Judicial Center 3 (Esperanza) has the potential for development to provide much needed 4 additional parking spaces for the general public, Superior Court employees, 5 tenants, patrons and clients. In this particular situation, the private landowner 6 is willing to work with the government of Guam in the way of a land 7 exchange to make this lot available for additional parking spaces without the 8 need for costly land condemnation. 9

Section 2. Exchange of Government Land Authorized. [*I Liheslaturan Guahan* authorizes] Notwithstanding any other provisions of law *I* Maga'lahen Guahan is authorized to exchange a portion of government land in

meters, valued at One Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Dollars (\$178,000) 1 based on an appraisal commissioned by the Superior Court with private land 2 designated as Lot Number 1332 New, Municipality of Hagatna, containing an area 3 of 532,76 square meters, as shown on Map Drawing Number 14-81T-135, dated 4 May 4.1981. Check Number 099-FY81 as recorded in the Department of Land 5 Management as Instrument 376039 on September 23, 1986 marked as Exhibit A. 6 The private land is valued at One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000) 7 based on an appraisal commissioned by the Superior Court. The owner of the 8 private land does not desire any other additional compensation to complete this 9 land exchange. 10

11 [Section 3. No Prohibition Against Building. Nothing contained in this Act 12 shall be construed to prevent or prohibit the party receiving government land from 13 improving such land or from building, creeting or constructing structures approved 14 in accordance with the building and zoning codes of Guam.]

15 [Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to 16 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law such invalidity 17 shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given 18 effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provision of 19 this Law are severable.]



The Chamorro Land Trust Commission is strongly opposed to the passage of Bill No. 380. This position was unanimously adopted pursuant to a motion on March 30, 2000, during a duly convened meeting.

On or about the middle of 1999, representatives of the Superior Court approached the Commission to discuss the possibility of the Commission acquiring Lot No. 1332 New, Agana, by way of a land exchange. It was their stated intention to expand their parking facilities. They were aware of the fact that the Commission has the authority to directly enter into land exchanges pursuant to §75105(e) of 21 GCA, which reads:

"(e) <u>The Commission may, in order to consolidate its holdings or to better</u> <u>effectuate the purposes of this Chapter, exchange the title to available lands</u> <u>for land of an equal value.</u> All lands so acquired by the Commission shall assume the status of available lands as though the same were originally designated as such under §75104." [emphasis added]

We fully understand the Courts desire to expand their inadequate parking facility. All we ask is that the Legislature and Courts recognize and respect the Commission's mandate to insure some form of equity is realized. Our position is in keeping with the authorization "to consolidate its holdings or to better effectuate the purposes of this Chapter." OFFICE OF

The Commission is in fact interested in acquiring Lot No. 1332 New, Agana. However, it is for the purpose of establishing a Commission owned commercial parking facility. It is our intention that it be operated on a revenue sharing basis by a qualified Chamorro, as provided pursuant to \$75107(c)(2) of 21 GCA, which, in pertinent part, reads:

"(c) The Commission is authorized to grant licenses for terms of not to exceed twenty-one (21) years in each case, The Commission is also authorized to grant licenses for lots within a village in which lands are leased under the provisions of this section, to:

"(2) theaters, **garages**, service stations, markets, stores, and other mercantile establishments (all of which shall be owned by lessees of the Commission or by organizations formed and controlled by said lessees)." [emphasis added]

The bottom line is, the Court needs additional parking, and the Commission needs revenue. Both ends can be readily achieved. It is for this reason that we respectfully ask to be allowed to accomplish this objective, on a win-win basis, on our own.

The Chamorro Land Trust Commission respectfully requests Bill No. 380 be reported out with a recommendation TO NOT PASS.

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
