Dear Legislative Secretary Brown:

Enclosed please find Bill No. 405 (COR), "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE I MAGA'LAHEN GUÅHAN TO CONVEY GOVERNMENT OWNED REAL PROPERTY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF AGAT, GUAM", which I have signed into law today as Public Law No. 25-135.

This legislation authorizes the Governor to even out the boundaries of the Namo River Flood Control Project with the adjacent landowner. When the Namo River was smoothed out in this project, small parcels were acquired from the adjacent landowner. In partial exchange for this acquisition, the adjacent landowner requests to have the boundaries smoothed out on their parcel. The amount of land involved total 4 parcels for  $935\pm$  square meters, ranging in sizes from 25 to  $560\pm$  square meters.

#### Committee Report March 30, 2000

The Committee on Land, Agriculture, Military Affairs, & the Arts held a public hearing on March 30, 2000 at the Public Hearing Room at the Legislative Building. The hearing was called to order at 9:10 a.m. by the Chairman, Senator Marcel G. Camacho.

#### Bill No. 405(COR): AN ACT AUTHORIZING I MAGA'LAHEN GUAHAN TO CONVEY GOVERNMENT OWNED REAL PROPERTY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF AGAT.

Present for the hearing were Senators Frank Aguon Jr., Eduardo B. Calvo, Lawrence F. Kasperbauer, John C. Salas, Alberto Lamorena V.

#### **Testimony Submitted by:**

Steffen Niu, GCIC

(Written/Oral)

#### Summary of Testimonies:

**The Chairman** summarized the bill, and explained that the owners of GCIC approached him to introduce it. He stated that the government had condemned a portion of GCIC's property in Agat to complete the Namo River Flood Control project, but failed to leave a smooth boundary line along the river. It was also pointed out that GCIC was never fully compensated for the condemnation. GCIC asked for partial compensation by returning certain pieces of government property along the river that are of no use. This will smooth out the boundary line for both the government and GCIC.

**Mr. Stephen Niu**, a representative from GCIC, read his written testimony which explained the situation in more detail (see attached). He then proceeded to display and explain a map of the area.

After a short discussion of the proposal, the **Chairman** stated for the record that the bill had been officially heard.

#### **COMMITTEE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION:**

The Government of Guam has successfully completed the Namo River Flood Control Project. GCIC is requesting that the Government of Guam convey four (4) parcels totaling approximately 935+/- square meters to them as partial compensation for the original condemnation. These parcels are of irregular shape. The sizes range from 25 +/- square meters to 560 +/- square meters. By executing the conveyance, GCIC and the Government will have a smooth curvilinear joint property line. Maintenance and upkeep of the propoerty will be systematic and not problematic. The site is currently multi-tiered. The government parcels to be conveyed are on the same elevation, as the property owned by GCIC. The lower tier is the government-owned property with the lowest tier being the river itself.

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The Committee on Land, Agriculture, Military Affairs and the Arts, to which was referred Bill No. 405(COR) wishes to report back its **recommendation to do pass** Bill No. 405(COR) as introduced.


# AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE *I MAGA'LAHEN GUAHAN* TO CONVEY GOVERNMENT OWNED REAL PROPERTY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF AGAT.

## **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guahan finds 2 that the Namo River Flood Control Project has been completed but not all 3 landowners have been compensated for land taken on August 4, 1977 under Civil 4 Guam Capital Investment Corp. ("Owner"), has not been 5 Case No. 620-77. compensated for their portion of property taken by the Government of Guam to 6 complete the Flood Control Project. A building, along with four (4) parcels totaling 7 Five Thousand Forty-five (5,045) Square Meters, was condemned for the use and 8 benefit of the people of Guam. Since September 23, 1996 the "Owner" had 9 requested the Department of Land Management to settle the condemnation case 10

through a combination of land exchange and cash compensation. To date the 1 Government has not responded to the request. The "Owner" is now interested in 2 obtaining certain parcels of land from the Government to "smooth out" his 3 boundary line. It is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guahan to authorize I Maga'lahen 4 Guahan to convey, as partial compensation for the condemnation, to the "Owner" 5 of Lot 236 such parcels as are needed to "smooth out" his boundary line. Guam 6 Capital Investment Corp. is currently exploring other avenues to settle the balance of 7 compensation due them. 8

Authorization to Convey. Notwithstanding any provision of 9 Section 2. law, rules or regulations, I Maga'lahen Guahan is authorized to convey, as partial 10 compensation for the condemnation, government real property designated as Parcels 11 "7", "9", "11" and "13" containing an area of Nine Hundred Thirty-five (935) 12 square meters, as shown on Land Management Drawing No. 1114-94, recorded 13 under Document No. 538201, Municipality of Agat, to Guam Capital Investment 14 Corporation ("Owner"). All administrative cost associated with the conveyance 15 16 shall be at the expense of the Government.

#### SUBJECT: Bill 405(COR) An Act to Authorize I Maga'Lahen Guahan to convey government owned real property in the Municipality of Agat.

Dear Senators:

In 1977, the Government of Guam acquired land as part of the Namo River Flood Control Project. That project in part, straightened out the course of the Namo River, which previously bordered much of our lot 236-REM, located in Agat. The newly designed river bed would subsequently intersect and occupy some of the land previously belonging to us. As part of the 1977 condemnation by the Government of Guam in Civil Case No. 620-77 and subsequent work on the project, a total 6,510 square meters of land were taken from us and used for this government project as shown in survey map #538201 as recorded with the Department of Land Management in 1995.

While we have been supportive of the intent of the project, to date we still have not received any compensation for the land and only this year have our tax records been updated to reflect the modified size so that we no longer pay taxes on the approximately 1 ½ acres which were taken from us 23 years ago.

We have made several overtures to the government to resolve this issue through just compensation which was never received by us and through the possibility of some land exchange, but have never received a conclusive answer, if any answer, and it is now 23 years later that we find ourselves still in this predicament.

I believe Bill 405(COR), is a first step in resolving this long time issue.

While the newly designed river bed is a smooth curvilinear line, some of the prior parcel remnants on the Lot236-REM side of the riverway remain, and show up as small irregular 'holes' in the joint property line of Lot 236-REM and the riverway. These small parcels are owned by the Government of Guam, but because of their small size and irregular shape are impracticable for any use unless used jointly with Lot 236-REM. The largest of the parcels numbers, 9 and 11, combined are only 826sm, and the smallest, # 13 is only 25sm, and none of the parcels has any access except from the riverproject right of way and from Lot 236-REM.

Therefore, Bill 405(COR) proposes to transfer these small irregular lots, whose combined size equals approximately 935 square meters) to GCIC as partial compensation for the 6,520 square meters which were taken.

I strongly support this bill and hope the senators of the 25<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature can help us to finally move forward in a resolution of this matter.

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# Lot 236-REM, Agat, Guam Land Condemnation

#### Chronology of Events

1976	Namo River Flood Control project announced. Requires land acquistion of 20 +/- acres of privately owned properties and 2 +/- acres of Naval properties. Government of Guam is to acquire the land by August 1st, 1977.
1977	July 19, 1977 letter from Director of Land Management (John P. Aguon) requesting purchase of parcels 6,8,12 & 14 of 5,045sm for \$16,080, plus portion of privately owned structure for \$4,170. Total Compensation of: \$20,251.
1977	GCIC Counter offer on land value of \$59,840 to be considered and a government appraisal to be performed. Land Management "will formally respond to [GCIC's] counter proposal upon completion of the appraisal report and its review."
1977	August 4, 1977, Ownership passes from GCIC to Government of Guam. "Estimated just compensation has been deposited with the Clerk of the District court in the amount" of \$20,251.00. GCIC is told by Land Management that "you may withdraw the compensation at any time."
7-Jul-80	Additional 5.5sm utilized by government for permanent catch basin (letter of July 7, 1980) from Dept of Corps of Engineers.
1981-1991	During this time GCIC waited for government action, however, the appraisal report as noted in letter of August 4, 1977 was never conducted by the government, and no money was picked up by GCIC from the Court. GCIC continued to be billed for property taxes on full 36,262sm of lot as prior to land condemnation. Verbal requests and telephone calls for information are inconclusive. During this time GCIC made various informal requests for action via telephone calls and personal visits but no conclusive action was ever reached. Subsequent requests for compensation were not conclusive.
1992-1995	GCIC pays for resurvey of the property with the new boundaries showing prior land and land taken. Mapping and approval process take 3 years, at cost of over \$17,000 to GCIC, and is not completed until 1995. Final Recorded Instrument #538201, dated 12/11/95 shows adjusted size of 36,262sm to 29,752sm, a loss of 6,510sm.
1996	Letter from GCIC, to Director of Land Management (Antonio Martinez) in September 1996, requesting resolution in the way of compensation and/or land swap. No response received from letter.
1997	Letter from GCIC, to Director of Land Management (Antonio Martinez) in September 1996, in follow up. No response received from letter.
1997	GCIC meets with Director of Land Management and is told they have no further responsibility on the matter, as they are not empowered to hold land nor to pay compensation.
1998	GCIC hires local law firm to represent interests and to investigate legal remedies. Firm is ultimately unsuccessful at obtaining compensation in land or in payment.
2000	Department of Revenue and Taxation, after follow-up by legislative office of the Chairman of Committee on Land, Agriculture, Military Affairs and the Arts, updates tax billing effective year 2000, and retroactive only to 1999, 1998.



# AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE *I MAGA'LAHEN GUAHAN* TO CONVEY GOVERNMENT OWNED REAL PROPERTY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF AGAT.

### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guahan finds 2 that the Namo River Flood Control Project has been completed but not all 3 landowners have been compensated for land taken on August 4, 1977 under Civil 4 Case No. 620-77. Guam Capital Investment Corp. ("Owner"), has not been 5 compensated for their portion of property taken by the Government of Guam to 6 complete the Flood Control Project. A building, along with four (4) parcels totaling 7 Five Thousand Forty-five (5,045) Square Meters, was condemned for the use and 8 9 benefit of the people of Guam. Since September 23, 1996 the "Owner" had requested the Department of Land Management to settle the condemnation case 10
