AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE I MAGA'LAHEN GUÅHAN TO EXCHANGE A PORTION OF AN ABANDONED PRE-WAR, BULL-CART TRAIL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TALOFOFO, GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. The owner of Lot
- 3 Number 26-1 in the Municipality of Talofofo, Guam has approached I
- 4 Liheslaturan Guåhan to advise I Liheslaturan Guåhan that a portion of Route 4-A
- 5 roadway, along with a guardrail, two (2) Guam Power Authority power poles

and an exposed two (2) inch Guam Waterworks Authority waterline is 1 encroaching into his lot's Northern boundary. In order to resolve the 2 encroachment, he has asked I Liheslaturan Guåhan to authorize I Maga'lahen 3 Guåhan to exchange the portion of an abandoned pre-war bull-cart trail which 4 runs along the Southern boundary of Lot Number 26-1, Talofofo, Guam with 5 an equally sized piece of property from Lot Number 26-1's Northern 6 boundary. By relocating the bull-cart trail, the encroachment problems will be 7 solved since the government will have approximately ten (10) additional feet 8 along the roadway for public access and utility easements. Lot Number 26-1, 9 10 Talofofo, Guam will eventually be consolidated with Lot Number 25-1, 11 Talofofo, Guam in order to make a more developable lot. I Liheslaturan 12 Guåhan views the land exchange as a win-win situation, since the bull-cart trail has not been in use since the development of Route 4-A and other 13 14 portions of it have been released in the past.

Section 2. Authorization to Exchange. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* is authorized to exchange with the owner of Lot Number 26-1, Municipality of Talofofo, Guam the portion of the abandoned pre-war bull-cart trail which runs along the Southern boundary of Lot Number 26-1, Talofofo, Guam with an equal area of Lot Number 26-1's Northern boundary.

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Section 3. Condition for Exchange. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all survey and administrative cost shall be at the expense of the owner of Lot Number 26-1, Talofofo, Guam.

Committee Report March 30, 2000

The Committee on Land, Agriculture, Military Affairs, & the Arts held a public hearing on March 30, 2000 at the Public Hearing Room at the Legislative Building. The hearing was called to order at 9:10 a.m. by the Chairman, Senator Marcel G. Camacho.

Bill No. 406(COR): AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE I MAGA'LAHEN GUAHAN TO EXCHANGE A PORTION OF AN ABANDONED PRE-WAR BULL-CART TRAIL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TALOFOFO.

Present for the hearing were Senators Frank Aguon Jr., Eduardo B. Calvo, Lawrence F. Kasperbauer, John C. Salas, Alberto Lamorena V.

Testimony Submitted by:

Mike Flaherty

(Oral)

Summary of Testimonies:

The Chairman summarized the bill, explaining that a property owner in Talofofo, Mr. Mike Flaherty, approached him to introduce this piece of legislation. He explained that the 24th Guam legislature addressed the return of a portion of the same trail to the adjacent property owners, since the bull-cart trail was no longer in use after the completion of Route 4A.

The Chairman continued to explain that there has been an injustice to Mr. Flaherty, since Route 4A encroaches into his property boundary, and an automobile guard rail, GWA water lines, and GPA power poles have been constructed on his private property adjacent to the roadway. Mr. Flaherty suggested that he exchange an equal amount of his private property adjacent to the roadway for the portion of the abandoned bull-cart trail that bisects his property. He is willing to exchange his property with the governments, on an area-forarea basis. This will allow him to consolidate his property into one developable lot, and the government will have additional land along the roadway for utility easements.

Mr. Flaherty then testified that he was looking for a solution to this problem that has been ongoing for many years, and this solution was fair and equitable. He has been prevented from developing his property in the past because of the bull-cart trail and the encroachment, and this exchange will allow him to move forward with his development.

Senator Salas added that in the 24th Guam legislature the Committee on Ways and Means had oversight of the disposal of government assets, and the situation has changed with the 25th legislature. The Committee on Land now has the oversight. He stated that he fully supports the intent of the bill.

Mr. Flaherty then suggested that the legislature address the exchange of the entire remainder of the bull-cart trail, allowing for additional easements for the future expansion of Route 4A.

The Chairman explained that it would be difficult to deal with all the adjacent property owners together, since some may have no interest in giving up valuable road frontage. The Chairman then stated that the bill had been officially heard.

COMMITTEE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION:

The Bull-cart trail is also the boundary line for Basic Lots 25 and 26.

When Route 4A was constructed it severed a part of Basic Lot 26 instead of using the Bull-cart trail and widening it to the required width.

The Tenorio family who own the lots adjacent to Mr. Flaherty has been authorized by Public Law 24-71 to purchase the bull-cart trail located on their property.

When Route 4A was reconstructed, the roadway encroached into the Northern boundary of Lot 26-1. Since then, various utility agencies have likewise encroached. Instead of having the various agencies compensate Mr. Flaherty for the encroachment, or relocating their hardware, it will be to everyone's advantage to execute an area for area land exchange between the government and Mr. Flaherty.

The Committee on Land, Agriculture, Military Affairs and the Arts to which was referred Bill No. 406(COR) wishes to report back with its **recommendation to Do Pass** Bill 406(COR) as introduced.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE I MAGA'LAHEN GUAHAN TO EXCHANGE A PORTION OF AN ABANDONED PRE-WAR BULL-CART TRAIL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TALOFOFO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

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- Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. The owner of Lot 26-1 in the
- 3 Municipality of Talofofo has approached I Liheslaturan Guahan to advise I
- 4 Liheslatura that a portion of Route 4-A roadway, along with a guardrail, two (2)
- 5 Guam Power Authority power poles and an exposed two (2) inch Guam Waterworks
- 6 Authority water line is encroaching into his lot's Northern boundary. In order to
- 7 resolve the encroachment, he has asked I Liheslaturan Guahan to authorize I
- 8 Maga'lahen Guahan to exchange the portion of an abandoned pre-war bull-cart trail
- 9 which runs along the Southern boundary of Lot 26-1 with an equally sized piece of
- property from Lot 26-1's Northern boundary. By relocating the bull-cart trail, the
- encroachment problems will be solved since the government will have approximately
- ten (10) additional feet along the roadway for public access and utility easements.
- Lot 26-1 will eventually be consolidated with Lot 25-1 in order to make a more

- developable lot. I Liheslatura views the land exchange as a win-win situation, since
- 2 the bull-cart trail has not been in use since the development of Route 4-A and other
- 3 portions of it have been released in the past.
- Section 2. Authorization to Exchange. Notwithstanding any other
- 5 provisions of Law, I Maga'lahen Guahan is authorized to exchange with the owner
- 6 of Lot 26-1, Municipality of Talofofo, the portion of the abandoned pre-war bull-
- 7 cart trail which runs along the Southern boundary of 26-1, with an equal area of Lot
- 8 26-1's Northern boundary.
- 9 Section 3. Condition for Exchange. Notwithstanding any other provisions
- of law, all survey and administrative cost shall be at the expense of the owner of Lot
- 11 26-1.
