



I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education held a public hearing on Thursday, June 1, 2000 at 9:00 a.m. at I Liheslaturan Public Hearing Room.

II. Testimony

Dr. James Craig testified in favor of the bill because it gives support to School Aides to be come certified teachers. He noted however that the due to a shortage in faculty and the College of Education, it would be difficult to accommodate school aides if their enrollment was limited to classes after school hours. He suggested that in lieu of stipends, leave with pay be considered and allow school aides to attend classes during the morning hours.

Mr. George Pereda testified in favor of the bill and affirmed Dr. Craig's position on the bill and suggested amendments.

Ms. Terrie Fejerang testified in favor of the bill and noted that she had been asked by Mr. Vince Leon Guerrero, DOE's Associate Superintendent for Secondary Education who was unable to attend, to relay his full support of the Bill. She noted that during her involvement in the School Aide training programs conducted at GCC, many candidates show promise and ability towards continuing their education and becoming successful teachers.

Dr. Aline Yamashita testified in favor of the bill but cautioned that the Committee that the bill should not include provisions suggested by other witnesses that allow Aides to be granted leave with pay so that they may attend morning classes. She noted that DOE faces a critical shortage of school personnel and that such problems will be compounded should Aides be allowed to attend classes during working hours.

III. Findings and Recommendation

The Committee on Education finds that there is considerable benefit in allowing individuals employed as school aides to participate in the Guam Teacher Corps. The Committee further finds that job experience with children will not only help in fulfilling degree and certification requirements but also result in producing teachers who are more likely to make teaching a life-long profession rather than teaching only until service credits are paid.

It is the recommendation of the Committee on Education that Bill No. 419 (LS) be reported out with the recommendation **TO DO PASS**.

I appreciate your invitation to provide testimony in support of Bill #419(LS). I believe that giving School Aides the opportunity and support to become certified teachers will benefit both the recipients and the people of Guam. I would, however, like to recommend certain amendments to the legislation. You may wish to consider a leave-with-pay provision such as found in the Doc Sanchez Scholarship. School aides will have difficulty getting College of Education classes if they are limited to after school hours. Due to our limited number of faculty we are unable to offer multiple sections of many courses and those courses are often only available during the day. If the aides are in a leave-with-pay status then stipends would become superfluous. Finally, as an editorial comment, please be advised that the original Guam Teacher Corps is now the Antonio C. Yamashita Educator Corps.



A BILL TO ENSURE A FULL SCHOOL DAY FOR KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS TO BE HEARD

A BILL AIMED TO ENSURE THAT KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS RECEIVE A FULL SCHOOL DAY EACH DAY THEY GO TO SCHOOL WILL BE HEARD TOMARROW MORNING BY THE LEGISLATURE'S COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION.

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW ITEM TO §18202 (b) OF ARTICLE 2 OF CHAPTER 18 OF TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO PROVIDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO SCHOOL AIDES EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO BECOME TEACHERS THROUGH THE GUAMTEACHER CORPS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Item (4) is hereby added to Section 18202 (b) of Article 2 of Chapter 18 of Title, Guam Code Annotated to read:

"(4) School Aides employed by DOE. Notwithstanding any other provision of law administrative rules and regulations, School Aides employed by the Department of Education may qualify for financial assistance through the Guam Teacher Corps and may (1) continue such employment while enrolled in the Guam Teacher Corps and (2) enroll in the Guam Teacher Corps on part-time basis. Those opting for part-time enrollment, must be enrolled in at least six (6) credit hours per semester and are entitled to a stipend equal to Fifty percent (50%) of the stipends provided for in item (1) of this Section. School aides enrolled on a full-time basis while maintaining employment in such capacity with the Department of Education are entitled to the full stipend amounts as provided by item (1) of this Section"

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
