
Should there be funds "left over" from previous appropriations, after the hiring of all necessary teachers for the classrooms, those funds will be used for textbooks. Very truly yours,

Committee Report On

Bill No. 458 (COR): AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO USE FUNDS APPROPRIATED UNDER PUBLIC LAW 25-98 FOR THE PURCHASE OF TEXTBOOKS AND LIBRARY BOOKS.

I. OVERVIEW

As Bill No. 458 (COR) is substantively identical to vetoed Bill No. 439 (LS) as passed by I Liheslaturan Guåhan, the Committee on Education did not hold a public hearing or request a Fiscal Note on the Bill.

II. Findings and Recommendation

The Committee on Education finds that Bill No. 458 (COR) is substantively identical to vetoed Bill No. 439 (LS) as passed in the June 2000 Regular Session of I Liheslaturan Guåhan. As noted in the report of the Clerk of the Legislature appended hereto, an error occurred in which two lines were missing from the enrolled copy of Bill No. 439 (LS) that was duly certified and transferred to I Maga Lahen Guåhan and subsequently vetoed.

The Committee finds that Bill No. 458 (COR) is substantively identical to Bill No. 439 (LS), that had a Public Hearing and was subsequently passed by the Legislature during the last session; therefore meeting the criteria of §2103 of Title 2 of the Guam Code Annotated for exemption of a public hearing.

The Committee further finds that providing DOE with the flexibility to use prior appropriations for the purchase of textbooks as vetoed Bill No. 439 (LS) would have provided for, continues to be of critical importance and therefore recognizes the urgency of immediate action by I Liheslatura on Bill No. 458 (COR).

It is the recommendation of the Committee on Education that Bill No. 458 (COR) be reported out with the recommendation **TO DO PASS.**

The Committee on Education reported Bill No. 439(COR) out of the Committee. Bill No. 439(COR) was placed on the Second Reading File on June 21, 2000. The Bill was substituted and debated on the Floor and placed on the Third Reading File on June 23, 2000.

The Legislative Counsel received Bill No. 439(COR) on disk from the Clerk of the Legislature's Office before voting. He incorporated technical changes and returned the disk back to the Clerk of the Legislature's Office. Same disk went to the Legislative Management Assistant for a printout.

Before a bill is finalized for engrossment, standard operating procedure of the Clerk's Office is followed, i.e. proofreading, making sure all amendments are intact and then a final engrossment copy is printed out.

At this point, the engrossment copy is provided to each Senator for voting. Senators voted upon the correctly engrossed Substitute Bill No. 439 (COR), copy attached.

However, during the enrollment process, two (2) lines were omitted from the Bill. Had this final proof reading procedure was done, the problem would have never occurred.
