Dear Legislative Secretary Brown:

Enclosed please find Substitute Bill No. 502 (COR), "AN ACT TO ADD §§8122(d)(4), 8129(e), 8135(d)(4) AND 8135(e)(3) TO TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ADDITIONS OF RECOMPUTED ANNUITIES" which I have signed into law as **Public Law No. 25-174**.

This legislation provides an appropriation of \$350,000 to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund. This appropriation is to pay for a COLA to additional retirees of the government. Public Law No. 25-72 provided for COLA payments to retirees who retired prior to January 1, 2000. The automatic COLA phases out on September 30, 2001, but in previous law was not applicable to all of those who retired during Fiscal Year 2000. This legislation applies the \$1,100 COLA payment to retirees, their survivors, and their minor surviving children, for those retirees retiring between the dates of January 1, 2000 and September 30, 2000. These individuals were not previously covered.







**AN ACT TO ADD §§8122(d)(4), 8129(e), 8135(d)(4)
AND 8135(e)(3) TO TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ADDITIONS OF
RECOMPUTED ANNUITIES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* in the
3 Budget Act, Public Law Number 25-72, enacted on September 2000, provided
4 that the Retirement Fund shall provide supplemental and COLA benefits to

1 retirees for a limited duration; namely, during the fiscal years commencing
2 October 1, 1998 through September 30, 2001. It has come to the attention of I
3 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* that language for COLA benefits applicable to members
4 contained in §4(d)(3) of Public Law Number 25-72 did *not* include those
5 receiving annuities on or after January 1, 2000, up to September 30, 2000. I
6 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* fully intended for these COLA benefits to be applicable to
7 all members and survivors receiving annuities and entitled to benefits under
8 Chapter 8 of Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated, consistent with the normal
9 September 30th cutoff for entitlement.

10 **Section 2.** Section 8122(d)(4) is hereby *added* to Article 1, Chapter 8 of
11 Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

12 “(4) Any member who commenced receiving a retirement
13 annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but *prior to* October 1, 2000, and who
14 is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal
15 year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, an
16 additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace
17 the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General
18 Appropriation Acts.”

19 **Section 3.** Section 8129(e) is hereby *added* to Article 1, Chapter 8 of Title
20 4 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

21 “(e) Any disability retirement annuitant who commenced
22 receiving a disability retirement annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but
23 *prior to* October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this
24 Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1,

1 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One
2 Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living
3 increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts."

4 **Section 4.** Section 8135(d)(4) is hereby *added* to Article 1, Chapter 8 of
5 Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

6 "(4) Any survivor annuitant who commenced receiving a
7 survivor annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but *prior to* October 1, 2000,
8 and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during
9 the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending September
10 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00),
11 to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in
12 various General Appropriation Acts."

13 **Section 5.** Section 8135(e)(3) is hereby *added* to Article 1, Chapter 8 of
14 Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

15 "(3) Any minor surviving children of a member, retirement
16 annuitant or disability retirement annuitant, who commenced receiving
17 minor child annuities provided under §8135 (a)(2) on or after January 1,
18 2000, but *prior to* October 1, 2000, and have no surviving parent, shall
19 receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and
20 ending September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred
21 Dollars (\$1,100.00), which shall be payable to their guardian for the
22 collective benefit of all surviving minor children entitled to receive
23 benefits under this Chapter, in order to replace the annual cost of living
24 increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts."

1 **Section 6. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of
2 Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) from the General Fund
3 to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund to fund the COLA benefits
4 authorized in §§2, 3, 4 and 5 of this Act.

AN ACT TO *AMEND* SECTION 8122 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (e) TO SECTION 8, TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION 4 TO SECTION 9 AND TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (3) ALL PERTAINING TO CHAPTER 4 OF P.L. 25-72, RELATIVE TO ADDITIONS OF RECOMPUTED ANNUITIES.

PUBLIC HEARING: The Committee on Housing, General Government Services and Foreign Affairs, to which was referred Bill No. 502 (COR) “AN ACT TO *AMEND* SECTION 8122 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (e) TO SECTION 8, TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION 4 TO SECTION 9 AND TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (3) ALL PERTAINING TO CHAPTER 4 OF P.L. 25-72, RELATIVE TO ADDITIONS OF RECOMPUTED ANNUITIES,” conducted a public hearing on Monday, March 27, 2000, at the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. Senator Kaleo S. Moylan, Chairperson of the Committee on Housing, General Government Services and Foreign Affairs convened the hearing promptly at 8:30 a.m. Also in attendance was Senator Vicente C Pangelinan.

TESTIMONY: Appearing before the Committee was Ms. Teresita Flores, Deputy Director of the Government of Guam Retirement Fund and Greg Perez Benefits Specialist. Ms. Flores informed the Chairman and members of the Committee that the Fund is in favor of Bill No. 502 (COR) as substituted incorporating the suggested from the Fund.

There being no further witnesses, the Chairperson adjourned the hearing, and moved onto the next item on the agenda.

FINDINGS: The Committee finds the Guam Legislature in the Budget Act (P.L. 25-72) enacted on September 2000, provided that the Retirement Fund shall provide supplemental and COLA benefits to retirees for a limited duration; namely, during the fiscal years commencing October 1, 1998 through September 30, 2001.

Furthermore, it has come to the attention of the Guam Legislature that language for the COLA benefits applicable to members contained in Section 4(d)(3) of P.L. 25-72 did not include those receiving annuities on or after January 1, 2000, up to September 30, 2000. The Guam Legislature fully intended for these COLA benefits to be applicable to all members and survivors receiving annuities and entitled to benefits under Chapter 8, Title 4 GCA consistent with the normal September 30th cutoff for entitlement.

RECOMMENDATION: The Committee, having reviewed Bill No. 502 (COR), "AN ACT TO *AMEND* SECTION 8122 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (e) TO SECTION 8, TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION 4 TO SECTION 9 AND TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (3) ALL PERTAINING TO CHAPTER 4 OF P.L. 25-72, RELATIVE TO ADDITIONS OF RECOMPUTED ANNUITIES," recommends that the legislation, as substituted, be passed by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

Recommendation: To do pass as substituted by the Committee.

A Closer Look

The Guam Legislature in the Budget Act (P.L. 25-72) enacted on September 2000, provided that the Retirement Fund shall provide supplemental and COLA benefits to retirees for a limited duration; namely, during the fiscal years commencing October 1, 1998 through September 30, 2001. Furthermore, it has come to the attention of the Guam Legislature that language for the COLA benefits applicable to members contained in Section 4(d)(3) of P.L. 25-72 did not include those receiving annuities on or after January 1, 2000, up to September 30, 2000. The Guam Legislature fully intended for these COLA benefits to be applicable to all members

and survivors receiving annuities and entitled to benefits under Chapter 8, Title 4 GCA consistent with the normal September 30th cutoff for entitlement.

Section Analysis

Section 2 of Substitute Bill No. 502 adds a new Subsection (4) to Section 4(d) of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72. The proposed Subsection (4) provides that any member who commenced receiving a retirement annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending of September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 3 of Substitute Bill No. 502 adds a new Subsection (e) to Section 8 of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72. The proposed amendment provides that any disability retirement annuitant who commenced receiving a disability retirement annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living incase formerly contained in various General Appropriations Acts.

Section 4 of Substitute Bill No. 502 adds a new Subsection (4) to Section 9(d) P.L. 25-72. The proposed amendment provides that any survivor annuitant who commenced receiving a survivor annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living incase formerly contained in various General Appropriations Acts.

Section 5 of Substitute Bill No. 502 adds a new Subsection (3) to Section 9(e) of P.L. 25-72. The proposed amendment provides that any minor surviving children of a member, retirement annuitant, or disability retirement annuitant, who commenced receiving minor child annuities provided under §8135 (a)(2) on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and have no surviving parent, shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), which shall be payable to their guardian for the collective benefit of all surviving minor children entitled to

receive benefits under this Chapter, in order to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 6 of Substitute Bill No. 502 appropriates the necessary sum of \$350,000.00 to implement the intent of this Act.

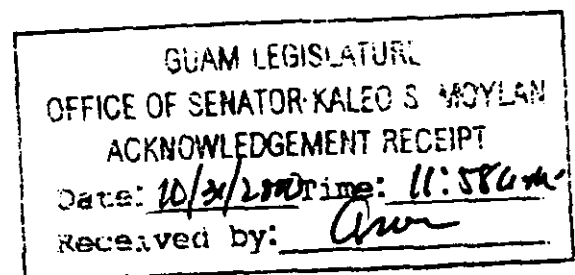



Whereas, I Liheslaturan Guahan in the Budget Act (P.L. 25-72) enacted on September 2000, provided that the Retirement Fund shall provide supplemental and COLA benefits to retirees for a limited duration; namely, during the fiscal years commencing October 1, 1998 through September 30, 2001; and

Whereas, it has come to the attention of I Liheslaturan Guahan that language for COLA benefits applicable to members contained in Section 4(d)(3) of P.L. 25-72 did not include those receiving annuities on or after January 1, 2000, up to September 30, 2000, and

Whereas, I Liheslaturan Guahan fully intended for these COLA benefits to be applicable to all members and survivors receiving annuities and entitled to benefits under Chapter 8, Title 4 GCA consistent with the normal September 30th cutoff for entitlement.

Section 2. A new subsection (4) is added to Section 4(d) of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72 to read:

(4) Any member who commenced receiving a retirement annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending of September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 3. A new subsection (e) is added to Section 8 of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72 to read:

(e) Any disability retirement annuitant who commenced receiving a disability retirement annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending of September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 4. A new subsection (4) is added to Section 9(d) of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72 to read:

(4) Any survivor annuitant who commenced receiving a survivor annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending of September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 5. A new subsection (3) is added to Section 9(e) of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72 to read:

(3) Minor surviving children of a member, retirement annuitant, or disability retirement annuitant, who commenced receiving minor child annuities provided under § 8135 (a)(2) on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and have no surviving parent, shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending on September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), which shall be payable to their guardian for the collective benefit of all surviving minor children entitled to receive benefits under this Chapter, in order to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 6. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) from the General Fund to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund to fund the COLA benefits authorized in Section 2, Section 3, Section 4, and Section 5 of this Act.

4 that the Retirement Fund shall provide supplemental and COLA benefits to

1 retirees for a limited duration; namely, during the fiscal years commencing
2 October 1, 1998 through September 30, 2001. It has come to the attention of I
3 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* that language for COLA benefits applicable to members
4 contained in §4(d)(3) of Public Law Number 25-72 did *not* include those
5 receiving annuities on or after January 1, 2000, up to September 30, 2000. I

PUBLIC HEARING: The Committee on Housing, General Government Services and Foreign Affairs, to which was referred Bill No. 502 (COR) “AN ACT TO *AMEND* SECTION 8122 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (e) TO SECTION 8, TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION 4 TO SECTION 9 AND TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (3) ALL PERTAINING TO CHAPTER 4 OF P.L. 25-72, RELATIVE TO ADDITIONS OF RECOMPUTED ANNUITIES,” conducted a public hearing on Monday, March 27, 2000, at the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. Senator Kaleo S. Moylan, Chairperson of the Committee on Housing, General Government Services and Foreign Affairs convened the hearing promptly at 8:30 a.m. Also in attendance was Senator Vicente C. Pangelinan.

TESTIMONY: Appearing before the Committee was Ms. Teresita Flores, Deputy Director of the Government of Guam Retirement Fund and Greg Perez Benefits Specialist. Ms. Flores informed the Chairman and members of the Committee that the Fund is in favor of Bill No. 502 (COR) as substituted incorporating the suggested from the Fund.

There being no further witnesses, the Chairperson adjourned the hearing, and moved onto the next item on the agenda.

FINDINGS: The Committee finds the Guam Legislature in the Budget Act (P.L. 25-72) enacted on September 2000, provided that the Retirement Fund shall provide supplemental and COLA benefits to retirees for a limited duration; namely, during the fiscal years commencing October 1, 1998 through September 30, 2001.

Furthermore, it has come to the attention of the Guam Legislature that language for the COLA benefits applicable to members contained in Section 4(d)(3) of P.L. 25-72 did not include those receiving annuities on or after January 1, 2000, up to September 30, 2000. The Guam Legislature fully intended for these COLA benefits to be applicable to all members and survivors receiving annuities and entitled to benefits under Chapter 8, Title 4 GCA consistent with the normal September 30th cutoff for entitlement.

A Closer Look

Furthermore, it has come to the attention of the Guam Legislature that language for the COLA benefits applicable to members contained in Section 4(d)(3) of P.L. 25-72 did not include those receiving annuities on or after January 1, 2000, up to September 30, 2000. The Guam Legislature fully intended for these COLA benefits to be applicable to all members

and survivors receiving annuities and entitled to benefits under Chapter 8, Title 4 GCA consistent with the normal September 30th cutoff for entitlement.

Section Analysis

Section 2 of Substitute Bill No. 502 adds a new Subsection (4) to Section 4(d) of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72. The proposed Subsection (4) provides that any member who commenced receiving a retirement annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending of September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 3 of Substitute Bill No. 502 adds a new Subsection (e) to Section 8 of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72. The proposed amendment provides that any disability retirement annuitant who commenced receiving a disability retirement annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living incase formerly contained in various General Appropriations Acts.

Section 4 of Substitute Bill No. 502 adds a new Subsection (4) to Section 9(d) P.L. 25-72. The proposed amendment provides that any survivor annuitant who commenced receiving a survivor annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living incase formerly contained in various General Appropriations Acts.

Section 5 of Substitute Bill No. 502 adds a new Subsection (3) to Section 9(e) of P.L. 25-72. The proposed amendment provides that any minor surviving children of a member, retirement annuitant, or disability retirement annuitant, who commenced receiving minor child annuities provided under §8135 (a)(2) on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and have no surviving parent, shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), which shall be payable to their guardian for the collective benefit of all surviving minor children entitled to

receive benefits under this Chapter, in order to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.



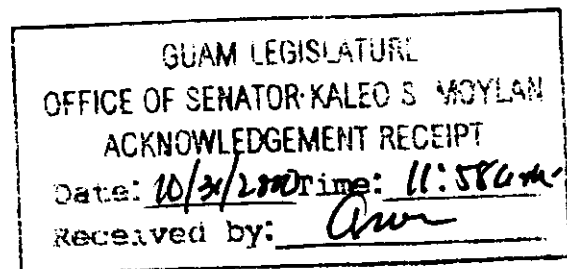

(e) Any disability retirement annuitant who commenced receiving a disability retirement annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending of September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 4. A new subsection (4) is added to Section 9(d) of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72 to read:

(4) Any survivor annuitant who commenced receiving a survivor annuity on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and who is entitled to benefits under this Chapter shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending of September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 5. A new subsection (3) is added to Section 9(e) of Chapter 4 of P.L. 25-72 to read:

(3) Minor surviving children of a member, retirement annuitant, or disability retirement annuitant, who commenced receiving minor child annuities provided under § 8135 (a)(2) on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to October 1, 2000, and have no surviving parent, shall receive, during the fiscal year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending on September 30, 2001, an additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), which shall be payable to their guardian for the collective benefit of all surviving minor children entitled to receive benefits under this Chapter, in order to replace the annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General Appropriation Acts.

Section 6. There is hereby appropriated the sum of *Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00)* from the General Fund to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund to fund the COLA benefits authorized in Section 2, Section 3, Section 4, and Section 5 of this Act.

5 provide supplemental and COLA benefits to retirees for a limited
6 duration; namely, during the fiscal years commencing October 1, 1998
7 through September 30, 2001; and

6 “(3) Any minor surviving children of a member, retirement annuitant,
7 or disability retirement annuitant, who commenced receiving minor child
8 annuities provided under §8135 (a)(2) on or after January 1, 2000, but prior to
9 October 1, 2000, and have no surviving parent, shall receive, during the fiscal
10 year commencing on October 1, 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, an
11 additional One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), which shall be
12 payable to their guardian for the collective benefit of all surviving minor
13 children entitled to receive benefits under this Chapter, in order to replace the
14 annual cost of living increase formerly contained in various General
15 Appropriation Acts.”

16 **Section 6. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of Three
17 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) from the General Fund to the
18 government of Guam Retirement Fund to fund the COLA benefits authorized in
19 Sections 2, 3, 4, and 5 of this Act.
