

Dear Legislative Secretary Brown:

Enclosed please find Bill No. 252 (COR), "AN ACT TO AMEND §24 OF CHAPTER IV OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 25-03, RELATIVE TO THE LEGAL COUNSEL FOR THE MAYORS' COUNCIL OF GUAM," which I have signed into law as **Public Law No. 25-185**.

Prior legislation, contained in Section 24 of Chapter IV of Public Law No. 25-03, indicated that the Attorney General shall be the legal counsel for the Mayors' Council of Guam. It also indicated that the Attorney General could designate an attorney in the private sector to act as the attorney for the counsel. The amendment contained in this legislation provides that the appointed attorney shall be paid from funds from the budget of the Department of Law.

Publicly Heard Friday, August 13, 1999

Bill 252: An act to amend Section 24, Chapter IV of Public Law No. 25-03, relative to the legal counsel for the Mayor's Council of Guam. Senator Carlotta A. Leon Guerrero

III. SYNOPSIS

Bill 252 proposes to amend Public Law 25-03 to add a new provision to require that any private attorney appointed by the Attorney General to act as legal counsel for the Mayor's Council in the event of a conflict of interest or workload problems, be paid from Department of Law funds.

IV. TESTIMONY

John Tarantino, Attorney General of Guam, testified in support of the bill, but questioned who would pay for this kind of counsel. Currently, he noted, such expenses are paid by the Governor's transfer authority. He further commented that, however, this is not a logical way to fund this.

Chairman Salas asked what happens when the Attorney General refuses to provide representation, as it did with the University of Guam, for specialized litigation. In UOG's case, a great cost was incurred to provide for private representation.

General Tarantino noted that now that the Organic Act has been amended, the Attorney General now represents the entire government of Guam. Now that the Attorney General is the Chief legal officer of the government, can a private attorney not designated by the Attorney General legally represent the government in any way?

In UOG's case, it was found that the Board Counsel determined that the Board did not need to get a sanctioned attorney to represent them nor had himself sanctioned to represent the university in litigation.

General Tarantino asked the Committee to look at existing statute dealing with the function and role of the Attorney General in relation to the government of Guam.

Frank Camacho, Executive Director of the Mayor's Council, testified in support of the bill. He noted that the Attorney General advised the Council that the Council does not have statutory ability to hire private legal counsel on its own. In one instance, the Mayor's Council was given a procurement violation for hiring outside legal counsel without the consent of the Attorney General. The primary issue, however, is that annual budget of each Mayor's office is just over \$30,000, making legal representation unaffordable. So while the Attorney General may assign outside, private representation, the Council could not afford to pay for it.

V. COMMITTEE FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATION

The Committee understands that the Attorney General's office may not be able to provide legal counsel to the Mayor's Council due to its many obligations. The Committee also finds that the Mayor's Council of Guam is inadequately funded to pay for private legal representation. While the Department of Law's budget may not be the best funding source, and the Legislature will have to examine the Attorney General's role for the entire government of Guam, it is a more stable source than the Governor's transfer authority. Therefore, the Committee recommends **TO DO PASS Bill 252**.

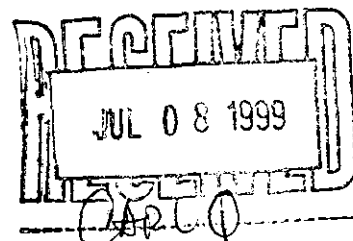

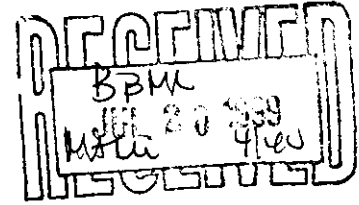


