1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Section 3105 of Chapter 3 of Title 12 of the Guam Code
- 3 Annotated is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Corporation shall be **"Section 3105. Board of Trustees.** governed by a Board of Trustees, who shall consist of seven (7) members of the general public: one (1) of whom must be employed as a classroom teacher with at least three (3) years of teaching experience, none of whom, except the classroom teacher, may be an employee of the government of Guam, who shall be appointed by I Maga'lahen Guahan with the advice of and consent of I Liheslaturan Guahan. The membership representing the general public shall serve for a term of four (4) years; provided, however, that in making the first appointment, I Maga'lahen Guahan shall designate three (3) persons to serve a one (1) year term, two (2) to serve a three (3) year term and two (2) persons to serve a four (4) year term. If a member appointed under this Subsection shall, during his term of office, permanently depart from the Island, resign or otherwise be unable to fulfill the responsibilities of the position, I Maga'lahen Guahan shall appoint a new member to fill the unexpired term in the same manner as prescribed for appointment to a new term. All members of the Board shall serve for the term specified or until their successors are appointed and qualified."



I. OVERVIEW

The Committee Education held a public hearing on Friday, May 5, 1999 at 9:00 a.m. at I Liheslaturan Public Hearing Room. Public Notice of the hearing was announced in the April 30th and May 4th 1999 issues of the Pacific Daily News.

II. Testimony

Ms. Ginger Underwood, Mr. Mesengei Diaz and Ms. Sonia Suobiron, KGTF. Ms. Underwood, Mr. Mesengei and Ms. Subiron testified jointly in full support of the Bill. They said that the addition of a classroom teacher would add greater depth in the selection of educational programming for the station. In response to questions

recommended that the classroom teacher member have at least three (3) years of teaching experience.

III. Findings and Recommendation

The Committee on Education finds that Bill No. 177 (COR) will add greater depth in educational programming by requiring that one (1) member of the Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation (d.b.a. KGTF) be a classroom teacher. The Committee agrees with the recommendation of witnesses that the teacher should possess at least three (3) years of teaching experience and has incorporated such recommendation in a substitute bill.

It is the recommendation of the Committee on Education that Substitute Bill No. 177 (COR) be reported out with the recommendation **TO DO PASS.**





The Bureau requests that Bill No(s). 177 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 177 proposes to amend §3105 of Chapter 3 of Title 12, Guam Code Annotated (GCA) relative to requiring that one (1) member of the Board of Trustees of the Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation (KGTF) be a classroom teacher. Presently, §3105 of Chapter 3 of 12 GCA stipulates that the Corporation's Board of Trustees shall "consist of seven (7) members of the general public, none of whom, shall be an employee of the government of Guam, who shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice of and consent of the Legislature." In so far as there are no provisions of law which exempt employees of the government of Guam from receiving stipends pursuant to §43104 of Chapter 43 of 5 GCA, the proposed legislation will not pose a fiscal impact to the government of Guam, as the make up of the said Board of Trustees will remain status quo at seven (7) members.


