2 governed by a Board of Trustees, who shall consist of seven (7)  
3 members of the general public: one (1) of whom must be employed as a  
4 classroom teacher with at least three (3) years of teaching experience,  
5 none of whom, *except* the classroom teacher, may be an employee of the  
6 government of Guam, who shall be appointed by *I Maga'lahaen Guahan*  
7 with the advice of and consent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan*. The  
8 membership representing the general public shall serve for a term of  
9 four (4) years; provided, however, that in making the first appointment,  
10 *I Maga'lahaen Guahan* shall designate three (3) persons to serve a one (1)  
11 year term, two (2) to serve a three (3) year term and two (2) persons to  
12 serve a four (4) year term. If a member appointed under this Subsection  
13 shall, during his term of office, permanently depart from the Island,  
14 resign or otherwise be unable to fulfill the responsibilities of the  
15 position, *I Maga'lahaen Guahan* shall appoint a new member to fill the  
16 unexpired term in the same manner as prescribed for appointment to a  
17 new term. All members of the Board shall serve for the term specified  
18 or until their successors are appointed and qualified."

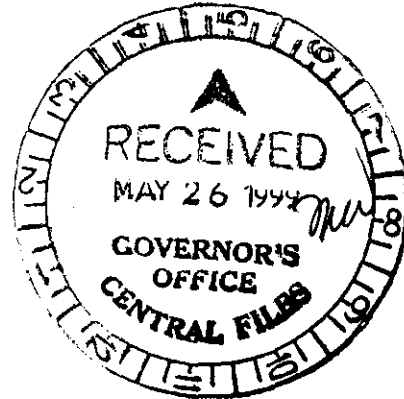



## **I. OVERVIEW**

The Committee Education held a public hearing on Friday, May 5, 1999 at 9:00 a.m. at I Liheslaturan Public Hearing Room. Public Notice of the hearing was announced in the April 30<sup>th</sup> and May 4<sup>th</sup> 1999 issues of the Pacific Daily News.

## **II. Testimony**

**Ms. Ginger Underwood, Mr. Mesengei Diaz and Ms. Sonia Suobiron, KGTF.** Ms. Underwood, Mr. Mesengei and Ms. Subiron testified jointly in full support of the Bill. They said that the addition of a classroom teacher would add greater depth in the selection of educational programming for the station. In response to questions

recommended that the classroom teacher member have at least three (3) years of teaching experience.

### **III. Findings and Recommendation**

The Committee on Education finds that Bill No. 177 (COR) will add greater depth in educational programming by requiring that one (1) member of the Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation (d.b.a. KGTF) be a classroom teacher. The Committee agrees with the recommendation of witnesses that the teacher should possess at least three (3) years of teaching experience and has incorporated such recommendation in a substitute bill.

It is the recommendation of the Committee on Education that Substitute Bill No. 177 (COR) be reported out with the recommendation **TO DO PASS**.

Dear Vice-Speaker Kasperbauer and Honorable Members of the Committee:

Why should a teacher become a board member for GETC/KGTF-TV?

A teacher should be a member of the Board for KGTF because a teacher is in close contact with a very important segment of our community - our island's children. For many years KGTF has informed, educated and influenced children through its wonderful children's programming. Enough cannot be said about the importance of reaching out and positively influencing our children in their early years. For it is during these years that their bodies and minds be nurtured through education resulting in knowledge. Instilling the value of morals which leads to compassion, respect, honor, integrity and dignity just to name a few, must also be done. To successfully achieve this, it must be done during their youth.

Our children's bodies, minds, souls and hearts must be positively shaped and molded like a delicate sculpture. The two main sculptors during these years are parents and teachers. In our opinion, a parent's role of responsibility need not to be explained-parents must be responsible to and for their children in all aspects of their children's lives. Enough said.

Teachers spend a great deal of time with our children on a daily basis. As a result, teachers have a great opportunity to positively affect our children's lives. Teachers know what children are thinking, saying and doing. Teachers are important links to our island's children.

Having a teacher on the Board of KGTF, would allow KGTF to have a direct link to our island's children. A teacher could then share the likes and dislikes of our children, as well as their interests. KGTF could better provide services to our children with this first hand information on the professional level of the teacher.

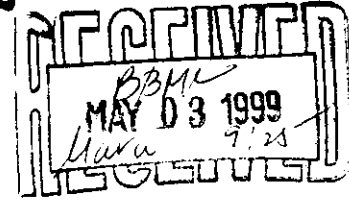



Bill No. 144 (COR) –AN ACT TO ADD NEW §§6411, 6411.1 AND 6411.2 TO CHAPTER 6 OF TITLE 17 RELATIVE TO GRANTING THE AUTHORITY TO SCHOOL PRINCIPALS TO SUBPOENA PARENTS OF STUDENTS WITH DISCIPLINARY PROBLEMS TO APPEAR AT SCHOOL TO CONTROL THEIR CHILDREN OR TO CONSULT WITH TEACHERS AND SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS.

Bill No 176 (COR) –AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS OF PUBLIC LAW NUMBER 24-59, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW 25-03, AND TO REPEAL CERTAIN SECTIONS OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 25-03, RELATIVE TO RESTORING GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM AND ITS VARIOUS STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS, FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS AND PROGRAM ADMINISTRATIONS, AND TO THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
