AN ACT TO MANDATE THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION TO CREATE THE POSITION OF MAMMOGRAPHY TECHNOLOGIST FOR THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY.

#### 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. The Guam Memorial Hospital Authority ('GMHA') provides mammography services within the Radiology Department. This unit provides stereo-tactic imaging for breast lesion localization through needle biopsy and mammography studies on women who are identified as high risk for breast malignancies at the earliest

1 possible time-based on Medicare guidelines, or at its earliest onset when the

2 condition is still manageable. GMHA averages twenty (20) patients a day for

3 mammography studies.

The Mammography Quality Standards Act, as established by the American College of Radiology and the Food and Drug Administration, requires that a registered Mammography Technologist must perform mammography studies in order to comply with the Act. No such position currently exists in the classified service of the government of Guam. *However*, the GMHA employee who actually conducts mammography studies is duly registered, but the position assigned to that individual is a Hospital Radiology Technologist.

GMHA is the only facility currently able to conduct mammography studies. Primary care clinics are sending their patients there and the backlog of appointments has resulted in people waiting as long as one (1) year for their examinations. The proper classification of the registered technologist becomes even more important to ensure that the sole entity capable of rendering this vital service continues to do so.

GMHA requested the Civil Service Commission ('CSC') create the Mammography Technologist position, but CSC declined, citing the hiring freeze invoked by §21 of Chapter V of Public Law Number 25-03. Because mammography examinations are effective in prevention and early detection of cancer, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* deems that the creation of this position is both critical for delivery of optimal health care service and in meeting the Mammography Quality Standards Act, and outside the scope and intent of the hiring freeze.

#### I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 275 (COR) was referred to this Committee on August 18, 1999 for disposition. A public hearing was conducted on September 3, 1999 at 9:00 AM in the Legislative Public Hearing Room. The hearing attendance record is attached to this report.

#### II. COMMITTEE FINDINGS

Representatives from the health industry, as well as those affected by cancer were present at the public hearing to voice their support for Bill 275. Evident was the sense of urgency from the presenters to pass Bill 275. A common factor shared by the presenters was that this bill would help to improve the quality of health care and devote its services to improving direct patient care for the women of Guam.

Written testimony was presented from the Civil Service Commission in favor of the intention of Bill 275, however, it is the position of the commission that new positions "should not be processed through legislation." Furthermore, it is the recommendation of the Commission that the committee forgo Bill 275 and instead approve a waiver from Public Law 25-03 and assign the Commission to resolve the matter administratively. The commission would have 30 days to report the findings.

#### III. COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Health, Human Services, and Chamorro Heritage recommends to the full body, on the voting of Bill 275 "An act to mandate the Civil Service Commission to create the position of mammography technologist," "To Pass."
