

**AN ACT TO MANDATE THE CIVIL SERVICE
COMMISSION TO CREATE THE POSITION OF
MAMMOGRAPHY TECHNOLOGIST FOR THE
GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** The Guam Memorial
3 Hospital Authority ('GMHA') provides mammography services within the
4 Radiology Department. This unit provides stereo-tactic imaging for breast
5 lesion localization through needle biopsy and mammography studies on
6 women who are identified as high risk for breast malignancies at the earliest

1 possible time-based on Medicare guidelines, or at its earliest onset when the
2 condition is still manageable. GMHA averages twenty (20) patients a day for
3 mammography studies.

4 The Mammography Quality Standards Act, as established by the
5 American College of Radiology and the Food and Drug Administration,
6 requires that a registered Mammography Technologist must perform
7 mammography studies in order to comply with the Act. No such position
8 currently exists in the classified service of the government of Guam. *However,*
9 the GMHA employee who actually conducts mammography studies is duly
10 registered, but the position assigned to that individual is a Hospital Radiology
11 Technologist.

12 GMHA is the only facility currently able to conduct mammography
13 studies. Primary care clinics are sending their patients there and the backlog
14 of appointments has resulted in people waiting as long as one (1) year for
15 their examinations. The proper classification of the registered technologist
16 becomes even more important to ensure that the sole entity capable of
17 rendering this vital service continues to do so.

18 GMHA requested the Civil Service Commission ("CSC") create the
19 Mammography Technologist position, but CSC declined, citing the hiring
20 freeze invoked by §21 of Chapter V of Public Law Number 25-03. Because
21 mammography examinations are effective in prevention and early detection
22 of cancer, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* deems that the creation of this position is both
23 critical for delivery of optimal health care service and in meeting the
24 Mammography Quality Standards Act, and outside the scope and intent of
25 the hiring freeze.

1 **Section 2.** Notwithstanding the provisions of §21 of Chapter V of
2 Public Law Number 25-03, the Civil Service Commission shall create in the
3 classified service of the government of Guam the position of Mammography
4 Technologist with the attendant qualifications and job description.

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 275 (COR) was referred to this Committee on August 18, 1999 for disposition. A public hearing was conducted on September 3, 1999 at 9:00 AM in the Legislative Public Hearing Room. The hearing attendance record is attached to this report.

II. COMMITTEE FINDINGS

Representatives from the health industry, as well as those affected by cancer were present at the public hearing to voice their support for Bill 275. Evident was the sense of urgency from the presenters to pass Bill 275. A common factor shared by the presenters was that this bill would help to improve the quality of health care and devote its services to improving direct patient care for the women of Guam.

Written testimony was presented from the Civil Service Commission in favor of the intention of Bill 275, however, it is the position of the commission that new positions "should not be processed through legislation." Furthermore, it is the recommendation of the Commission that the committee forgo Bill 275 and instead approve a waiver from Public Law 25-03 and assign the Commission to resolve the matter administratively. The commission would have 30 days to report the findings.

III. COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Health, Human Services, and Chamorro Heritage recommends to the full body, on the voting of Bill 275 "An act to mandate the Civil Service Commission to create the position of mammography technologist," **"To Pass."**





1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
3 *finds that as a result of the enactment of the "Dave Santos Small Business*
4 *Enhancement Act"* (P.L. No. 24-12) that business will be required to make their
5 deposits of Gross Receipt Taxes ("GRTs") by the fifteenth (15th) of each month
6 effective October 1, 1997. This date coincides with the date of the month

1 many businesses, especially small business, are required to make deposits for
2 withholding and estimated taxes. The present requirement of paying GRTs
3 on the twentieth (20th) of each month allowed many businesses greater
4 flexibility in cash flow management. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to
5 change the required date of deposit of GRTs from the fifteenth (15th) of each
6 month to the twentieth (20th) of each month.

7 **Section 2.** Section 26110.1 of Article 1, Chapter 26, Division 1 of Title 11
8 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:


9 **“Section 26110.1. Deposit of Gross Receipts Taxes.**

10 All taxpayers against whom a tax is levied by the provisions of Article 2
11 of this Chapter shall deposit Gross Receipt Taxes on a monthly basis.
12 The taxes due for any calendar month shall be deposited no later than
13 the twentieth (20th) day of the following month. The Gross Receipts
14 Taxes shall be deposited at authorized banks, financial institutions or at
15 designated offices of the government of Guam.”

I. PUBLIC HEARING

BILL NO. 161 (LS) was as introduced on March 23, 1999 and referred to the Committee on Power, Public Works, Tax and Regulatory Reform, Municipal and Community Affairs (“the Committee”) on April 13, 1999. Fiscal Note was requested from the Bureau of Budget and Management Research on April 21, 1999; as of August 11, 1999, the Committee has not received said Fiscal Note.

The Committee called a public hearing to order at 1:50 p.m., Friday, July 2, 1999 to hear testimony on **BILL NO. 161 (LS)**. The hearing was held in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* in Hagåtña. Notices were placed in the Pacific Daily News in compliance with stipulations mandated for proper notification of the public.

The hearing was called to order by Senator Eddie Baza Calvo, Chairman of the Committee. Vice-Speaker Lawrence F. Kasperbauer was in attendance.

No members of the public were present to testify and no written testimony was submitted.

II. TESTIMONY

VICE-SPEAKER KASPERBAUER stated that with the enactment of the “Dave Santos Small Business Enhancement Act” (Public Law 24-12) the required date of deposit of Gross Receipts Taxes (“GRT”) was changed from the twentieth (20th) to the fifteenth (15th) of each month. Consequently, businesses have had to pay not only withholding and estimated taxes on the fifteenth (15th) of each month, but GRT as well. With all of these payments due on the same date, and with many businesses currently experiencing hardships because of the downturn in the economy, Bill No. 161 (LS) seeks to assist these businesses by “delaying” the date of deposit (of GRT) to the twentieth of each month.

There being no further oral or written testimony, the public hearing on Bill No. 161 (LS) concluded at 2:00 p.m.

III. FINDINGS

The Committee finds that amending the date of the deposit of GRT [from the fifteenth (15th) to the twentieth (20th) of each month] will provide businesses the extra time that may be necessary for the abatement of cash-flow constraints. It may also afford businesses the opportunity to exercise more flexibility in cash-flow management; something that would greatly assist those who have been adversely affected by the decline in the island's economy.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Power, Public Works, Tax and Regulatory Reform, Municipal and Community Affairs does hereby report out **BILL NO. 161 (LS)** to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, with the recommendation **TO DO PASS**.

9 on the twentieth (20th) of each month allowed many businesses greater
10 flexibility in cash flow management. It is the intent of the Guam Legislature

1 to change the required date of deposit of GRTs from the fifteenth (15th) of
2 each month to the twentieth (20th) of each month.

4 **Section 2.** Subsection 26110.1. of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated is
5 hereby amended to read:

6 **“§26110.1. Deposit of Gross Receipts Taxes.** All taxpayers against
7 whom a tax is levied by the provisions of Article 2 of this Chapter shall
8 deposit Gross Receipt Taxes on a monthly basis. The taxes due for any
9 calendar month shall be deposited no later than the ~~fifteenth (15th)~~ twentieth
10 (20th) day of the following month. The Gross Receipts Taxes shall be
11 deposited at authorized banks, financial institutions or at designated offices
12 of the Government of Guam.”
