Enclosed please find Substitute Bill No. 495 (COR), "AN ACT TO AMEND §80107(b) OF TITLE 10 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED AND TO AMEND §13 OF P.L. NO. 25-150, RELATIVE TO THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY HOSPITAL ADMINISTRATOR AND CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER," which I have signed into law as **Public Law No. 25-183**.

Without this legislation, the salaries would be capped at a level where it may not be possible to attract the type of individuals that Guam would like.

## I. OVERVIEW

Summarize bill's content: Bill No. 495(COR) seeks to provide for the attraction of qualified applicants to the positions of Guam Memorial Hospital Authority Administrator and Chief Financial Officer by offering base salaries that are competitive with the salary levels paid to comparable positions in the U.S. mainland.

Bill No. 495(COR) was introduced on October 18, 2000, referred to the Committee on Health, Human Services and Chamorro Heritage on XXX, 2000, and publicly heard on Thursday, December 7, 2000.

## II. COMMITTEE FINDINGS

The Committee finds that in order to attract qualified applicants to the positions of Hospital Administrator and Chief Financial Officer, it is necessary to offer base salaries that are competitive with salary levels of comparable positions in similar-sized hospitals in the U.S. mainland.

Bill No. 495(COR) authorizes the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority Board of Trustees, in consultation with the Civil Service Commission, to hire a Hospital Administrator at a salary that may not exceed step 20 of Pay Grade V, or \$138,800 per annum. Similarly, the Hospital Administrator may hire a Chief Financial Officer, in consultation with the Civil Service Commission, at a salary not to exceed step 20 of Pay Grade V.

The Committee finds that attracting qualified applicants to these two critical positions will strengthen GMH's management team and answer one of the points listed by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Health Care Organizations (JCAHCO) in a recent assessment report. Further, the committee finds that authorizing the Board of Trustees to hire these positions as either an unclassified employee or under an employment contract provides an additional method of attracting qualified applicants.

No testimonies were received during the public hearing. However, written testimony was received from the Civil Service Commission (CSC) on Tuesday, December 12, 2000. The CSC recommends that line 10 on page 1, and line 6 of page 2 "may not exceed step 20 of Pay Grade V of the GovGuam Unified Pay Schedule" be excluded. It also recommends that the following language be inserted: "The Civil Service Commission shall review the salaries of the Hospital Administrator and the Chief Financial Officer positions for the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority. The Commission shall consider income levels of private and government practitioners on Guam and worldwide. Implementation of the salary structure of these positions is subject to the approval of the Civil Service Commission." These recommendations are made by the Commission to remove these positions from the Government of Guam Uniform and Unified Pay Schedule, and to establish a pay structure similar to that of physicians, dentists, and attorneys. By making these changes the Commission believes that any possible "domino effect" on the Government of Guam Uniform and Unified Pay Schedule will be avoided. It should be noted for the record, that the bill had been reviewed by the Commission *prior* to its introduction, and that its language *after* introduction reflected the Commission's review and suggested changes.

## III. COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Health, Human Services and Chamorro Heritage, to which was referred Bill No. 495(COR), has completed its public hearing and deliberations on the same and reports the substitute bill to the body with a recommendation to "DO PASS".

*Hafa Adai!* The Civil Service Commission thanks you for the opportunity to provide written testimony on Bill No. 495.

The Commission is suggesting to exclude line 10 of page 1 and line 6 of page 2 "may not exceed step 20 of Pay Grade V of the GovGuam Unified Pay Schedule". Instead, we recommend the following:

"The Civil Service Commission shall review the salaries of the Hospital Administrator and the Chief Financial Officer positions for the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority. The Commission shall consider income levels of private and government practitioners on Guam and nationwide. Implementation of the salary structures of these positions is subject to the approval of the Civil Service Commission."

This recommendation is similar to the establishment of the pay structure for physicians, dentists, and attorneys. Thus, it will not create a "domino effect" on the Government of Guam Uniform and Unified Pay Schedule.
