

2 **Section 1.** Section 18102 of Article 1, Chapter 18, Division 3 of Title
3 17 of the Guam Code Annotated, as added by Public Law Number 24-231, is
4 hereby *amended* to read as follows:

1 **“Section 18102. Educator Corps Council Composition.**

2 The Educator Corps shall consist of seven (7) members. These members
3 are: the Dean of the College of Education of the University of Guam;
4 the Personnel Administrator for the Department of Education; the
5 Associate Superintendent for Special Education of the Department of
6 Education; a school principal from the Department of Education; a
7 guidance counselor from the Department of Education; a secondary
8 school teacher who has been a master teacher for at least one (1)
9 semester from the Department of Education or the Guam Community
10 College; and an elementary school teacher who has been a master teacher
11 for at least one (1) semester from the Department of Education. The
12 principal, guidance counselor and teacher shall be appointed by the
13 Director of Education. The members of the Council shall elect a
14 chairperson among themselves to preside over all meetings of the
15 Council. The College of Education of the University of Guam shall
16 provide logistics and personnel necessary for the operation of the
17 Council, and the University of Guam shall serve as the custodian for the
18 Program’s funds and records. The Educator Corps Director shall serve in
19 a non-voting, *ex-officio* capacity as the Executive Secretary of the
20 Council.”

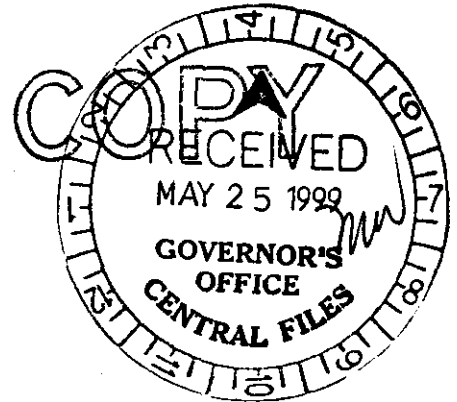



I. OVERVIEW

The Committee Education held a public hearing on Friday, May 5, 1999 at 9:00 a.m. at I Liheslaturan Public Hearing Room. Public Notice of the hearing was announced in the April 30th and May 4th 1999 issues of the Pacific Daily News.

II. Testimony

Dr. Jose T. Nededog, President, University of Guam, Dr. Nededog testified in favor of the Bill. He also testified that the Board of Regents has no objection to the Bills provisions.

Dr. James L. Craig, Dean College of Education, University of Guam & Chairperson of the Educator Corps Council. Dr. Craig testified in favor of the Bill. He noted that the proposed Council composition did not substantially differ from its present form. He also added that he spoke with GCC Vice President Dr. John Rider who also had no objection.

Mr. Fred Nishihira, Staff Attorney, Department of Education. Mr. Nishihira testified that DOE had no objection to the provisions of the Bill.

III. Findings and Recommendation

The Committee on Education finds that Bill No. 146 (COR) that, as a result of Judge Steven Unpingco's ruling on Public Law 24-142, changes are necessary to the Dr. Antonio C. Yamashita Educator Corps Council. The present Council composition was based on a membership that will exist because of the implementation of P.L. 24-142.

It is the recommendation of the Committee on Education that Bill No. 146 (COR) be reported out with the recommendation **TO DO PASS.**

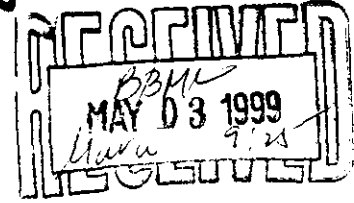

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

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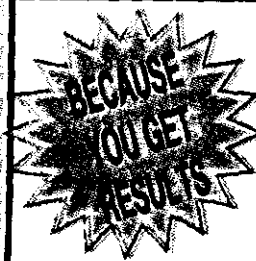
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
