AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$100,000.00 FOR EMERGENCY EXPENDITURES FOR THE MARCH 11, 2001 DEDEDO SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION FIRE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. At 11:30 p.m. on March 11, 2001, Acting Maga'lahen Guåhan Madeleine Z. Bordallo declared a state of emergency as a result of the intensification of a fire at the
- 5 Department of Public Work's Dededo Solid Waste Transfer Station, which

1 intensification escalated a threat to public health and safety from the

2 intense and dense smoke clouds emanating from the fire. The Guam Fire

3 Department, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency and the

4 Department of Public Health and Social Services all recognized the

5 immediate emergency and danger to the public, and immediately

mobilized their staff and personnel to effectively plan and handle the most

immediate needs of the emergency.

I Mina'Bente Sais Na Liheslaturan Guåhan recognizes the need for the declaration of an emergency and commends Acting Maga'lahen Guåhan Bordallo, and the aforementioned departments and agencies of the government of Guam for the expeditious actions in this situation. The immediate, effective and efficient actions of the Acting Maga'lahen Guåhan, and the agency and department heads of the government, recognize the fact that the Executive Branch of government has the capacity, ability, authority and responsibility to act without a moment's hesitation.

Notwithstanding this capacity, ability, authority and responsibility, this emergency session of *I Mina'Bente Sais Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*, as convened by the Speaker, is called to provide legislative recognition of the emergency, the need for emergency funding, and the potential need to replenish funds which may have been transferred and utilized to secure services or procure material at a moment's notice and where necessary. *I Mina'Bente Sais Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* also recognizes and restates its policy that there will be accountability for all funds expended under this and any emergency declaration.

Section 2. Appropriation Authorization. provide To for 1 expenditures incurred in fighting, controlling and extinguishing the fire at 2 the Department of Public Work's Dededo Solid Waste Transfer Station on 3 or about March 11, 2001, and for providing for emergency services to care 4 5 for citizens who may have had to be evacuated as a result of said fire, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby 6 appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Military Affairs, 7 Office of Civil Defense, for the purpose of reimbursing agencies and 8 9 departments which may have incurred expenditures as a result of the 10 declaration of emergency. Section 3. Reporting Requirement. 11 I Maga'lahen Guåhan shall 12 prepare, or have prepared, a report no later than the thirtieth (30th) day after 13 the declaration of emergency, (in this case, no later than April 11, 2001) on all transfers, expenditures and reimbursements by all and any agency or 14 15 department, directly related to the fighting, controlling and extinguishing

All reports required herein shall be submitted to the Speaker of *I*Mina'Bente Sais Na Liheslaturan Guåhan no later than the close of business on

April 12, 2001.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO TRANSFER THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR EMERGENCY EXPENDITURES FOR THE DEDEDO SOLID WASTE TRANSFER FIRE ON 11 MARCH 2001.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

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Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent: At 2230 hours on March 11, 2001, Acting Governor Madeleine Z. Bordallo declared a state of emergency as a result of the intensification of a fire at the Department of Public Work's Dededo Solid Waste Transfer Station which intensification escalated a threat to public health and safety from the intense and dense smoke clouds emanating from the fire. The Guam Fire Department, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of Public Health and Social Services all recognized the immediate emergency and danger to the public and immediately mobilized their staff and personnel to effectively plan and handle the most immediate needs of the emergency. I Mina Bente Sais na Liheslaturan Guahån recognizes the need for the declaration of an emergency and commends Acting Governor Bordallo and the aforementioned departments and agencies of the Government of

Guam for their expeditious actions in this situation. The immediate, 1 effective and efficient actions of the Acting Governor and the agency and 2 Department heads of the Government recognizes the fact that the 3 Executive Branch of government has the capacity, ability, authority and 4 responsibility to act without a moment's hesitation. Notwithstanding this 5 capacity, ability, authority and responsibility, this emergency session of I 6 Mina Bente Sais na Liheslaturan Guahån, as convened by the Speaker, is 7 called to provide legislative recognition of the emergency, the need for emergency funding, and the potential need to replenish funds which may 9 have been transferred and utilized to secure services or procure materiel at 10 a moments notice and where necessary. I Mina Bente Sais na Liheslaturan 11 Guahån also recognizes and restates its policy that there will be 12 accountability for all funds expended under this and any emergency 13 14 declaration.

Transfer Authorized. To provide for expenditures 15 Section 2. incurred in fighting, controlling and extinguishing the fire, and for 16 providing for emergency services to care for citizens who may have had to 17 be evacuated as a result of said fire, at the Department of Public Work's 18 Dededo Solid Waste Transfer Station, the Governor of Guam is 19 20 authorized to transfer no more than the sum of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000.00), from the unexpended balance of 21 22 the FOUR MILLION THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,300,000.00) INS-GUAM-99-1A Grant, Catalog No. CFDA 15.875, 23 received on 25 September 2000, expiration on 30 September 2001, for the 24 25 purpose of reimbursing agencies and departments which may have 26 incurred expenditures as a result of the declaration of emergency.

Section 3. Reporting requirement. The Governor of Guam shall prepare or have prepared, a report[s], no later than the thirtieth day (30th) after the declaration of emergency, (in this case, no later than 11 April 2001) on all transfers, expenditures and reimbursements by all and any agency or department, directly related to the fighting, controlling and extinguishing of the fire covered by the declaration of emergency by Acting Governor Madeleine Z. Bordallo on 11 March 2001. All reports required herein shall be submitted to the Speaker of I Mina Bente Sais na Liheslaturan Guahån no later than the close of business 12 April 2001.
