Dear Legislative Secretary Brown:

Enclosed please find Substitute Bill No. 044 (COR) entitled: "AN ACT TO REPROGRAM FUNDS FROM GOVERNMENT BOND SOURCE FOR THE IMMEDIATE REPAIRS TO THE GUAM WATERWORKS AUTHORITY FUJITA, CHAOT AND ROUTE 16 LIGUAN TERRACE PUMP STATIONS" which I have signed into law as Public Law No. 26-05.

This legislation allows the reprogramming of \$548,280 from the unreserved or unencumbered balance of the Water System Project Fund of the 1989 government of Guam Water System Revenue Bond for repairs of the Guam Waterworks Authority's Fujita Pump Station, the Chaot Pump Station, and the Route 16 Liguan Terrace Pump Station. Funds are also reprogrammed for the reconstruction of the telemetry system.

To ensure that this process will occur uninterrupted, GWA has further determined that the generator at the Route 16 Liguan Terrace Pump Station must be repaired, and that an emergency shut-off switch be installed to protect the safety of GWA pump station employees and generator equipment.

Section 4. Required Report. The Bureau of Budget and Management Research shall provide a written financial and management report to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* by May 9, 2001, and every two (2) weeks thereafter until completion of the projects, containing information as to exactly how the Executive Branch has distributed the bond funds identified in this Act, and whether the projects identified herein have been completed. *If* any or several of the projects identified in this Act are *not* completed by the report's due date, then the report shall explain in detail why the projects were *not* effectuated and the recommendations to complete the projects.

Section 5. Maintenance Schedule and Status Reports. After completion of the projects herein, Guam Waterworks Authority shall establish and submit to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* a maintenance schedule for each of the projects, and continuing status reports upon completion of the regular maintenance items.

Section 6. Severability. *If* any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.

To ensure that this process will occur uninterrupted, GWA has further determined that the generator at the Route 16 Liguan Terrace Pump Station must be repaired, and that an emergency shut-off switch be installed to protect the safety of GWA pump station employees and generator equipment.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan acknowledges and commends the Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association and tourism industry members for their interest and intended financial support to immediately address the repairs to the Fujita Pump Station and the Route 16 Liguan Terrace Pump Station. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that it is in the interest of all parties to fund these repairs from government bond sources to avoid any further financial burden on Guam's tourism industry, which has already suffered greatly as a result of the sewage overflow from the Fujita Pump Station in Tumon.

Section 2. Reprogramming and Appropriation of Bond Funds. The sum of Five Hundred Forty-eight Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$548,280.00) is hereby appropriated, notwithstanding any other provision of law, to the Guam Waterworks Authority from the unreserved or unencumbered balance of the Water System Project Fund of the 1989 Government of Guam Water System Revenue Bond.

Section 3. Pump Station Repair Projects and Cost. The Guam Waterworks Authority is hereby authorized to expend the reprogrammed bond funds identified in §2 of this Act *only* for the following pump station repairs and telemetry system reconstruction *up to* the following amounts:

Section 4. Required Report. The Bureau of Budget and Management Research shall provide a written financial and management report to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* by May 9, 2001, and every two (2) weeks thereafter until completion of the projects, containing information as to exactly how the Executive Branch has distributed the bond funds identified in this Act, and whether the projects identified herein have been completed. *If* any or several of the projects identified in this Act are *not* completed by the report's due date, then the report shall explain in detail why the projects were *not* effectuated and the recommendations to complete the projects.

Section 5. Maintenance Schedule and Status Reports. After completion of the projects herein, Guam Waterworks Authority shall establish and submit to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* a maintenance schedule for each of the projects, and continuing status reports upon completion of the regular maintenance items.

Section 6. Severability. *If* any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.
