Dear Legislative Secretary Brown:

Enclosed please find Bill No. 051 (COR) entitled: "AN ACT TO ADD §22430 TO TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING GOVERNMENT NOTICES AND ADVERTISEMENTS TO INCLUDE A DISCLOSURE STATEMENT" which I have signed into law as Public Law No. 26-12.

This legislation requires all government paid ads to state that they are government paid ads, and which agency or entity of the government paid for the ad.

This legislation includes all three branches of government. While ads placed by the Executive Branch are printed under the heading or logo of the department or agency placing the ad, now the ads must also include "paid for by" prior to the heading or logo, or indicate in some other location within the ad which agency paid for the ad. This "paid for by" requirement pertains to judicial notices, as well as to legislative public hearing and other notices.



5 the expenditure is for official business.

1 It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to require any public notice,
2 advertisement or message issued by an agency and paid for using
3 government funds to disclose that it is paid for by government funds. Under
4 this policy, use of public funds will be *subject to* greater public scrutiny and
5 questionable expenditures will be checked.

6 **Section 2.** Section 22430 is hereby *added* to Article 4, Chapter 22,
7 Division 2 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

8 **“Section 22430.** (a) Any public notice, advertisement or
9 message issued by an agency, or agencies, and paid for, partially
10 or fully, using government funds, shall include a disclosure
11 statement that the public notice, advertisement or message is paid
12 for by government funds, and the name of the agency or agencies
13 paying for the notice.

14 (b) As used in this Section, ‘*Agency*’ means any authority
15 of the government and includes a department, institution, board,
16 bureau, commission, council, committee of territorial government,
17 branch, autonomous instrumentality or other public entity of the
18 government of Guam, whether or not it is within or subject to
19 review by another agency.”

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Statement. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that a government must be accountable to its citizens at all times. Hence, in expending government funds, any agent of the government must ensure that the expenditure is for official business.

It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to require any public notice, advertisement or message issued by an agency and paid for using government funds to disclose that it is paid for by government funds. Under this policy, use of public funds will be subject to greater public scrutiny and questionable expenditures will be checked.

Section 2. A new §22429 is added to 5 GCA to read as follows:


“§22429. (a) Any public notice, advertisement or message issued by an agency or agencies and paid for, partially or fully, using

1 government funds shall include a disclosure statement that the public
2 notice, advertisement or message is paid for by government funds, and
3 the name of the agency or agencies paying for the notice.

4 (b) As used in this Section, *Agency* means any authority of the
5 government and includes a department, institution, board, bureau,
6 commission, council, committee of territorial government, branch,
7 autonomous instrumentality, or other public entity of the government of
8 Guam, whether or not it is within or subject to review by another
9 agency."

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §22429 TO TITLE 5,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
REQUIRING ANY PUBLIC NOTICE,
ADVERTISEMENT OR MESSAGE ISSUED BY A
GOVERNMENT AGENCY USING GOVERNMENT
FUNDS TO INCLUDE A DISCLOSURE
STATEMENT.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Statement.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that a
3 government must be accountable to its citizens at all times. Hence, in
4 expending government funds, any agent of the government must ensure that
5 the expenditure is for official business.

6 It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to require any public notice,
7 advertisement or message issued by an agency and paid for using
8 government funds to disclose that it is paid for by government funds. Under
9 this policy, use of public funds will be subject to greater public scrutiny and
10 questionable expenditures will be checked.

11 **Section 2.** A new §22429 is added to 5 GCA to read as follows:

12 “§22429. (a) Any public notice, advertisement or message
13 issued by an agency or agencies and paid for, partially or fully, using

1 government funds shall include a disclosure statement that the public
2 notice, advertisement or message is paid for by government funds, and
3 the name of the agency or agencies paying for the notice.

4 (b) As used in this Section, *Agency* means any authority of the
5 government and includes a department, institution, board, bureau,
6 commission, council, committee of territorial government, branch,
7 autonomous instrumentality, or other public entity of the government of
8 Guam, whether or not it is within or subject to review by another
9 agency."
