AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT § 79104 OF TITLE 12, AND TO AMEND § 6113 OF TITLE 17, ALL OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO APPROVING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF **NEGOTIATED** LOAN BETWEEN MAGA'LAHEN GUÅHAN, THROUGH GEDCA, AND **FOR** THE **BANK OF** GUAM, AND **OTHER** PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Loan Approval. The terms and conditions of the loan
- 3 negotiated between I Maga'lahen Guåhan through the agency of the Guam

1	Economic Development and Commerce Authority ("GEDCA") and the Bank
2	of Guam ("BOG") in the amount of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000), as
3	authorized by Public Law Numbers 26-84 and 26-122, are hereby approved.

Section 2. Section 79104 of Chapter 79, Division 2 of Title 12 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *repealed and reenacted* to read as follows:

"Section 79104. Reporting Requirements. Commissioners and candidates for the Office of Commissioner shall be subject to the same reporting requirements pertaining to their campaign contributions and expenditures as apply to candidates and members of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Commissioners and candidates for the Office of Commissioner shall be required to file a personal disclosure statement that shall contain the following items:

- (a) the source of all wages and commissions paid to the Commissioner, or candidate for the Office of Commissioner;
- (b) a list of all corporations or partnerships in which the Commissioner, or candidate for the Office of Commissioner, has a material interest of five percent (5%) or greater; *and*
- (c) a list of all corporations, partnerships or sole proprietorships in which the Commissioner, or candidate for the Office of Commissioner, has a material interest of fifty percent (50%) or more.

A candidate for the Office of Commissioner shall be required to file the personal disclosure statement required by this Section with the Guam Election Commission upon filing that person's candidacy with the Guam Election Commission. A Commissioner is required to file the personal disclosure statement required by this Section on an annual basis on the same dates personal financial disclosures are required from members of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan.*"

Section 3. Extension of Filing Deadline for 2002 Election for Consolidated Commission on Utilities. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, including 3 G.C.A. § 6112, as repealed and reenacted by Public Law Number 26-119, the filing deadline for candidates for the Consolidated Commission on Utilities shall be by 5:00 p.m. on September 20, 2002 for the 2002 election year.

Section 4. Nothwithstanding any other provision of law, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* approves and grants a one (1) foot variance from yard setback requirements of the Zoning Law of Guam for Lot 16, Block 11, Tract 232, Municipality of Sinajana Urban Renewal Project.

Section 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all lots with homes built in accordance with applicable laws, rules and policies in effect at the time of construction are hereby granted a variance of the zoning law setback requirements to prevent a designation of the lot as non-conforming as a result of the conversion of "dotted line" easements into "severed lot" easements upon resubdivision of the lot subsequent to the approved construction of the home on the lot. The Department of Land Management shall report to *I liheslaturan Guåhan* a list of all lots granted a variance pursuant to this Section.

Section 6. Section 6113 of Article 1, Chapter 6, Division 1 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated, as amended by Public Law Number 26-96 and amended and renumbered further by Public Law Number 26-104, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

"Section 6113. Guaranteed Admission of Children. No student who is regularly and legally enrolled in a school within the public school system shall be refused to be placed in a classroom for which the student is eligible, as determined by the school administrator following guidelines established by the Board's policies.

No child wishing to attend school, who has reached that child's sixteenth (16th) birthday, and has *not* reached that child's nineteenth (19th) birthday, may be denied admission to a public school on the basis of age."
