#### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education held a public hearing on Wednesday, September 25, 2002 at 9:30 a.m. at I Liheslatura Public Hearing Room.

#### II. Testimony

**Dr. John Rider** testified in favor of the Bill. He suggested that the coverage of the Student Loan Program for technology education be expanded beyond the MCSE and CCNA designations to include other technology certifications. He noted that GCC has been offering many such training programs, most of which are funded by private companies or government agencies for such companies or agencies exclusive employment needs and that individual students desiring such training must often look outside of Guam.

**Dr. Jeff Barcinas** testified in favor of the bill but cautioned members of the Committee that because of the limited amount of scholarship funds, that adding too many more programs to the student loan program without additional funding may make it difficult to keep up with demand.

#### III. Findings and Recommendation

The Committee finds that all though the Microsoft MCSE and Cisco CCNA designations are the certifications most sought by employers with regards to recruitment of IT (Internet and Technology) technicians and professionals, it the recommendations made during the hearing that the other technology related certification training be covered under the Student Loan Program and included such recommendations in a substitute bill. The Committee also recognizes that funding for such offerings my be limited and there for has placed the responsibility of determining priorities on the Board of Trustees of the Guam Community Collage in the substitute bill.

It is the recommendation of the Committee on Education that Substitute Bill No. 375 (COR) be reported out with the recommendation **TO DO PASS.**

## OVERSIGHT HEARING ON LOCALLY FUNDED SCHOLARSHIP AND LOAN PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM

I Liheslatura's Committee on Education will conduct an oversight hearing on the University of Guam concerning locally-funded loan and scholarship programs. According to Vice Speaker Kasperbauer, who chairs the Committee on Education, matters to be discussed at Tuesday's hearing center around locally funded loans and scholarships and the critical areas the university has identified for priority in awarding such loans and scholarships.

Kasperbauer said he would like feedback from university officials on their efforts to collect account receivables resulting from loan defaults and as well concerns raised by loan and scholarship recipients who have been calling his office complaining about disbursements not being made on time.



AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §15205 TO CHAPTER 15 OF TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO ALLOWING THE USE OF STUDENT LOAN FUNDS TO ASSIST STUDENTS IN THE COMPLETION OF THE ACADEMIC PORTION OF RECOGNIZED APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING AND FOR STUDIES RELATED TO PREPARTION OF THE MICROSOFT CERTIFIED SOFTWARE ENGINEER (MCSE) AND CERTIFIED CISCO NETWORK ASSOCIATE (CCNA) DESIGNATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Section 15205 is hereby added to Chapter 15 of Title 17, Guam
- 3 Code Annotated to read:

- 4 §15205. Student loans For Specialized Training at the Guam
- 5 Community College.
- 6 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of §15201 of this Article, student loans
- 7 authorized under this Article may be used for following training programs
- 8 conducted at or approved by the Guam Community College:
- 9 (1) Courses required for the academic portions of U.S. Department Of Labor
- 10 approved apprenticeship programs.
- 11 (2) Courses required for the passage of exams and attainment of the
- 12 Microsoft Certified Software Engineer (MCSE) designation.
- 13 (3) Courses required for the passage of exams and attainment of the
- 14 Certified Cisco Network Associate (CCNA) designation.

(b) The maximum loan amounts shall be the lower of (1) the actual cost of tuition, fees, books and other course related items or (2) the limits set forth in §15202 of this Article subject to a two (2) year maximum completion time.

(c) Repayment terms shall be consistent with the terms of §15203 of this Article and shall begin upon completion of the apprenticeship program or passage of certification exams whichever applies, however, in the event a loan recipient fails to pass all certification exams within one (1) year following the completion of training, the amount of the loan shall be repaid in cash plus interest at the rate determined by §15203(a) of this Article.
