3 "Section 3217. Department of Education's District Action 4 Plan.

The Department of Education is hereby authorized to create a 'District Action Plan' in support of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001. The Department of Education's District Action Plan shall be established by policy of the Guam Education Policy Board."

**Section 2.** Section 5121 is hereby *added* to Chapter 5, Division 1 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

#### "Section 5121. Bonuses, Rewards and Incentives Program.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Department of Education is hereby authorized to create a 'Bonuses, Rewards and Incentives Program' for the recruitment and retention of teachers, school administrators and licensed healthcare professionals employed at the Department of Education. The Bonuses, Rewards and Incentives Program shall be consistent with the Department of Education's District Action Plan as authorized by 17 G.C.A. § 3217 and shall be subject to the availability of funds. The criteria, rules and regulations for the Bonuses, Rewards and Incentives Program shall be established by policy of the Guam Education Policy Board."

#### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, and Federal, Foreign and General Affairs held a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. on December 24, 2002 in the Public Hearing Room, Office of Senator Kaleo Moylan, Hagatna, Guam.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

There were no written or oral testimonies presented to the committee on Bill No. 429.

#### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Rules, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, and Federal, Foreign and General Affairs finds that the "No Child Left Behind Act of 2001" requires school districts to improve the education level of its school programs. Recruiting and retaining highly qualified teachers and school administrators by providing incentives are essential to this goal.
