AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE UNRESERVED FUND BALANCES OF THE VILLAGE STREETS FUND AND THE TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES FOR PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*finds that by the end of Fiscal Year 2001, public assistance programs at the
 Department of Public Health and Social Services will be unable to make
 public assistance payments in the aggregate amount of Four Million Dollars
 (\$4,000,000).
 - Because public welfare recipients depend upon these programs to provide for their basic necessities, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that it is in the best interests of these recipients to cover this Four Million Dollar (\$4,000,000) shortfall.
 - It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the unreserved fund balance of the Village Streets Fund and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the unreserved fund balance of the Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Health and Social Services for public assistance programs for Fiscal Year 2001.
 - Section 2. Appropriation to Public Health from Village Streets Fund for Public Assistance Programs. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is hereby appropriated Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the unreserved fund balance within the Village Streets Fund to the Department of Public Health and Social Services to be used *exclusively* for public assistance payments of public assistance programs for Fiscal Year 2001.
 - Section 3. Appropriation to Public Health from Territorial Highway Fund for Public Assistance Programs. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is hereby appropriated Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the

- 1 unreserved fund balance within the Territorial Highway Fund to the
- 2 Department of Public Health and Social Services to be used exclusively for
- 3 public assistance payments of public assistance programs for Fiscal Year 2001.
- 4 Section 4. Restriction Upon I Maga lahen Guåhan's Transfer
- 5 Authority. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, I Maga lahen Guåhan
- 6 shall not use his transfer authority to utilize any monies appropriated herein,
- 7 and said funds shall *not* be transferred or used for any other purpose.
- 8 **Section 5. Reversion of Funds.** Notwithstanding the general
- 9 provisions of § 22406 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, which require
- 10 that unused and de-appropriated funds revert to the General Fund, or any
- 11 other provision of law to the contrary, all unused funds appropriated herein
- shall, in all circumstances, and whether in whole or in part, revert back to the
- 13 Village Streets Fund and the Territorial Highway Fund.
- 14 Section 6. Reporting Requirement. The Department of Public
- 15 Health and Social Services shall submit a detailed report of the expenditures
- of the funds appropriated by this Act to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan,
- 17 and to the Chairpersons of the Committee on Ways and Means and the
- 18 Committee on Public Works, Health and Human Services of I Liheslaturan
- 19 Guåhan within sixty (60) days following the close of Fiscal Year 2001.
- Section 7. Effective Date. The provisions of this Act shall become
- 21 effective *immediately* upon enactment.
- Section 8. Section 5001(d) of Part A, Article 1, Chapter 5, Division 1 of
- 23 Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

"(d) Policy Concerning Sheltered Workers or Persons with Disabilities. If any entity of the government of Guam or any entity expending governmental funds intends to procure any supply or service which is offered by a nonprofit corporation employing sheltered workers or persons with disabilities, or a government of Guam entity employing sheltered workers or persons with disabilities, then that entity shall procure such supply or service from that nonprofit corporation or government entity if the supply or service is available within the period required by the procuring entity.

(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any nonprofit corporation or government of Guam entity employing sheltered workers or persons with disabilities that had an existing contract or contract in force on March 1, 2001, with the government of Guam, which shall include line agencies and autonomous agencies of the government of Guam such as the Guam Power Authority, the Guam Telephone Authority and the Department of Education, shall continue said contracts for two (2) years hence, ending March 31, 2003."

Section 9. Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.

I. PUBLIC HEARING

BILL NO. 129 (COR) was introduced on July 16, 2001 and referred to the Committee on Public Works, Health and Human Services ("the Committee") on July 19, 2001. Fiscal note was requested from the Bureau of Budget and Management Research on July 19, 2001 and was received on July 24, 2001. Fiscal Note requested from the Bureau of Budget and Management Research July 19, 2001 was received on July 24, 2001. (See attachment B)

The Committee called a public hearing to order at 9:16 a.m., Wednesday, July 25, 2001 to hear testimony on **BILL NO. 129 (COR)**. The hearing was held in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* in *Hagåtňa*. Notices were placed in the Pacific Daily News in compliance with stipulations mandated for proper notification of the public.

The hearing was called to order by Senator Eddie Baza Calvo, Chairman, Committee on Public Works, Public Health and Social Services, with Senators Tom C. Ada and Frank B. Aguon, Jr. in attendance.

II. <u>TESTIMONY</u>

Mr. Dennis Rodriguez and Ms. Diana Calvo testified in support of the measure.

II. FINDINGS

By the end of Fiscal Year 2001, public assistance programs at the Department of Public Health and Social Services will be unable to make public assistance payments in the aggregate amount of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00). The Committee finds that public welfare

recipients depend on these programs to provide for their basic necessities and wellbeing. The Committee further finds the appropriation of the Four Million Dollar (\$4,000,000.00) shortfall will be in the best interest of these recipients. Recognizing such, the Committee finds that Bill No. 129 (COR) be amended to appropriate Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) from the unappropriated surplus funds of the Village Streets Fund and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) from the unappropriated surplus funds of the Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Health and Social Services for public assistance programs for Fiscal Year 2001. Other amendments to the bill include technical corrections, that notwithstanding the general provisions of §22406 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, which require that unused and de-appropriated funds revert to the General Fund, or any other provision of law to the contrary, all unused funds appropriated shall, in all circumstances, and whether in whole or in part, shall revert back to the Village Streets Fund and the Territorial Highway Fund.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Public Works, Health and Human Services does hereby report out **SUBSTITUTE BILL NO. 59 (COR)**, to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, with the recommendation **TO DO PASS.**



BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan 3 finds that by the end of fiscal year 2001, public assistance programs at the 4 Department of Public Health and Social Services will be unable to make 5 public assistance payments in the aggregate amount of Four Million Dollars 6 (\$4,000,000.00). Because public welfare recipients depend on these programs 7 to provide for their basic necessities, I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that it is in the best interests of these recipients to cover this Four Million Dollar 8 9 (\$4,000,000.00) shortfall. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is hereby appropriated Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) from the Village Streets Fund to the Department of Public Health and Social Services to be used exclusively for public assistance payments of public assistance programs for fiscal year 2001.

Section 3. Same: Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is hereby appropriated Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) from the Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Health and Social Services to be used *exclusively* for public assistance payments of public assistance programs for fiscal year 2001.

Section 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, *I Maga lahen Guåhan* shall *not* use his transfer authority to utilize any monies appropriated herein and said funds shall *not* be transferred or used for any other purpose.

Section 5. Notwithstanding the general provisions of §22406 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, which require that unused and deappropriated funds revert to the General Fund, or any other provision of law to the contrary, all unused funds appropriated herein shall, in all circumstances, and whether in whole or in part, remain in the Department of Public Health and Socials Services fund and shall be carried over into the next fiscal year and shall be used *exclusively* to fund public assistance payments of public assistance programs for that fiscal year.
