





**AN ACT TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO
THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Appropriation to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority**
3 **from Tax Lien Collections Paid.**

4 (a) All monies collected by the Department of Revenue and
5 Taxation as a result of any and all tax levies placed upon the Guam
6 Memorial Hospital Authority ("Authority") bank accounts, or upon any
7 of the Authority's accounts receivables due from its customers,

1 including, but *not* limited to Levy No. 010900015, dated September 10,
2 2001; Levy No. 010900016, dated September 10, 2001, and any monies
3 collected from direct payments made by the Authority, or its successor,
4 in order to pay past due tax obligations, shall be deposited into the
5 General Fund.

6 **(b) Appropriation to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority.**

7 An amount *not to exceed* Six Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars
8 (\$6,600,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund in Fiscal
9 Year 2001 to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority.

10 **Section 2.** The appropriations for "Personnel" to the Department of
11 Integrated Services for Individuals with Disabilities ("DISID") in **Attachment**
12 **A** of Public Law Number 25-164 is hereby *amended* as follows:

13 (a) The sum of One Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Two
14 Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars (\$135,237.00) is appropriated from the
15 General Fund to the Department of Integrated Services for Individuals
16 with Disabilities, *specifically* for Fiscal Year 2001 local matching
17 requirement for Basic Support 110 Vocational Rehabilitation Federal
18 Program.

19 (b) The appropriations made in Subsection (a) of this Section
20 shall *not* be used for any other purpose and is *not* subject to *I Maga'lahaen*
21 *Guahan's* transfer authority under § 5 of Chapter V of Public Law
22 Number 26-01, or any other form of transfer authority *I Maga'lahaen*
23 *Guahan* may have.

1 **Section 3.** Section 4(c) of Public Law Number 25-176 is hereby *amended*
2 to read as follows:

3 “(c) The Sum of One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars
4 (\$140,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the
5 Department of Education for library books to be allocated at Twenty
6 Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) each for the following schools:
7 Oceanview Middle School, Jose Rios Middle School, Machananao
8 Elementary School, As Tumbo Elementary School, Chief Brodie
9 Memorial Elementary School, F. Q. Sanchez Elementary School and
10 Mount Santa Rosa Elementary School.”

11 **Section 4. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Law or its
12 application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to
13 law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this
14 Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application,
15 and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Appropriation to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority**
3 **from Tax Lien Collections Paid by the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority**
4 **into the General Fund.** (a) All monies collected by the Department of
5 Revenue and Taxation as a result of any and all tax levies placed upon the
6 Guam Memorial Hospital Authority bank accounts, or upon any of the
7 Authority's accounts receivables due from its customers, including, but *not*
8 limited to Levy No. 010900015, dated September 10, 2001, Levy No.
9 010900016, Dated September 10, 2001 and any monies collected from direct
10 payments made by the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority, or its successor,
11 in order to pay past due tax obligations, shall be deposited into the General
12 Fund.

13 (b) **Appropriation to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority.** An
14 amount *not to exceed* Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000.00) is appropriated
15 from the General Fund in Fiscal Year 2001 to the Guam Memorial Hospital
16 Authority.
