Enclosed please find Bill No. 316 (COR) "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$100,000.00, RELATIVE TO ADDRESSING THE DECLARATION OF A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY ON THE MEASLES OUTBREAK" which I have signed into law as Public Law No. 26-82.

With the current inadequate appropriations to the Department of Public Health and Social Services, such that our daily health needs are shortchanged, it is necessary for this legislation to be enacted immediately in order to provide the necessary funds for immunizing our young children from the threat of the measles disease. This disease in some cases is fatal and in other cases causes severe complications. Our very young children are the population which are most at risk and must be protected.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$100,000.00, RELATIVE TO ADDRESSING THE DECLARATION OF A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY ON THE MEASLES OUTBREAK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Hundred Thousand Dollars **Section 1.** Appropriation. One (\$100,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the 3 Department of Public Health and Social Services upon the declaration of a 4 public health emergency, and upon notification to the United States Center for 5 Disease Control ("CDC"), to address, mitigate or abate any catastrophic 6 7 disease control situations relating to the spread of measles on Guam. Any unexpended funds from this appropriation shall be immediately reverted back 8 9 into the General Fund.

Section 2. No later than sixty (60) days after the lifting of the declaration of a public health emergency, the Department of Public Health and Social Services shall report to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* a detailed breakdown of the expenses on the appropriation made pursuant to § 2 of this Act.

Section 3. Severability. *If* any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.

I, Antonio R.
