AN ACT TO AMEND § 3110 OF TITLE 3 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO VOTER REGISTRATION CLERKS.

#### 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Section 3110 of Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Guam Code
- 3 Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 3110. Qualifications for Registration Clerks.
- 5 (a) The Commission may appoint any qualified elector as
- a district or volunteer registration clerk. The Commission shall
- 7 establish by regulation the minimum qualifications for

appointment as a registration clerk. The Commission, pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Law, shall set forth a training program for registration clerks, which shall include passage of a standardized examination of the applicant's knowledge of the election laws necessary to perform the registration clerk's duties. No person holding an elective office or who is a candidate, or nominee for elective office, shall be appointed or serve as a registration clerk.

- (b) Term of Appointment. Any elector appointed as a registration clerk shall serve a limited term, which shall last from the date of appointment until midnight on the day that is twenty-one (21) days *before* the next regularly scheduled general election. The Commission shall promulgate policies and procedures to carry out the intent of this Section. The Commission may also establish other terms of appointment, consistent with the intent of this Section, for special elections, plebiscites, initiatives and any other non-general elections as they deem necessary to allow for voter registration to be conducted by duly appointed registration clerks.
- (c) Grandfather Clause. Any elector appointed as a registration clerk after January 1, 2001, and prior to the enactment of this Act, shall be *automatically* appointed as a registration clerk for a term consistent with the provisions of this Act, as if previously appointed registration clerk was duly appointed for a term under the provisions of this Act."

#### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, and Federal, Foreign and General Affairs held a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. on January 25, 2002 in the Public Hearing Room, I Liheslaturan Guahan. Public notice was given in the January 24 and 25, 2002 editions of the Pacific Daily News.

Senators present at the public hearing were:

Senator Mark Forbes, Chairman Senator Joanne Brown, Member Senator Ben Pangelinan, Member Senator Lou Leon Guerrero, Member Senator Judith WonPat Senator Frank Aguon Jr.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

There was no testimony submitted and no individuals appeared to testify on Bill No. 202.

#### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Rules, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, and Federal, Foreign and General Affairs finds that Bill No. 202, as amended, is needed because of the great importance of voter registration clerks to the sanctity of the election process, which is a cornerstone of any democracy.

Accordingly, the Committee on Rules, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, and Federal, Foreign and General Affairs, to which Bill No. 202 was referred does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to I Mina' Bente Sais Na Liheslaturan Guahan **TO DO PASS BILL NO. 202, as amended:** "An act to amend §3110 of Title 3, GCA relative to voter registration clerks".
