- **Section 2.** Section 5702(d)(1) of Article 12, Chapter 5 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:
- "(1) One (1) member shall be a member in good standing of the Guam Bar Association who has been admitted to practice before the highest court of a state, territory or the District of Columbia for *at least* five (5) years *prior* to that person's appointment, one (1) member shall be a certified public accountant, one (1) member shall have demonstrated experience of *at least* five (5) years in procurement, one (1) businessperson and three (3) members from the community-at-large."
 - **Section 3.** Section 5702(d)(2) of Article 12, Chapter 5 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:
- "(2) No member shall be an employee of the government of Guam nor a member of any board or commission of the government of Guam."

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, and Federal, Foreign and General Affairs held a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. on January 25, 2002 in the Public Hearing Room, I Liheslaturan Guahan. Public notice was given in the January 24 and 25, 2002 editions of the Pacific Daily News.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

There was no testimony submitted and no individuals appeared to testify on Bill No. 244.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Rules, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, and Federal, Foreign and General Affairs finds that Bill No. 244 is an important measure because of the strong need for a Procurement Appeals Board, which has yet to be filled.

Accordingly, the Committee on Rules, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, and Federal, Foreign and General Affairs, to which Bill No. 244 was referred does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to I Mina' Bente Sais Na Liheslaturan Guahan **TO DO PASS BILL NO. 244:** "An act to amend Section 5702 (d) subsections (1) and (2) of Article 12 of Division 1 of Chapter 5 Guam Code Annotated relative to the qualifications of the board members of the Procurement Appeals Board".

IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

1 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Mina'Bente Sais Na 2 Liheslaturan Guahan finds that a need exists for a Procurement Appeals 3 Board. I Mina'Bente Sais Na Liheslaturan Guahan further finds that the 4 absence of a duly constituted Procurement Appeals Board has resulted in 5 deviations from established procurement practices and laws that have 6 resulted in arbitrary decisions by agency directors and procurement 7 officers. Attempts to fill vacancies in the Procurement Appeals Board by 8 the I Mina'Bente Sais Na Liheslaturan Guahan have been thwarted by I 9 Maga'lahen Guahan. Therefore it is the intent of I Mina'Bente Sais Na 10 Liheslaturan Guahan to change the qualifications of the Procurement 11 Appeals Board to allow for greater community involvement. 12 Section 2. Amendment to Section 5702 (d), Subsections (1) and (2) 13 of Article 12, of Division 1 of Chapter 5 of the Guam Code Annotated is 14 amended to read as follows: 15

> One (1) member shall be a member in good standing of the (1)Guam Bar Association who has been admitted to practice before the highest court of a state, Territory or the District of

	Columbia for at least five (5) years prior to his appointment,
	one (1) member shall be a certified public accountant and the
	other one (1) members shall have demonstrated experience of at
	least five (5) years in procurement - , one (1) businessperson
	and three (3) members from the community at large.
(2)	No member shall be an employee of the government, a
	recipient of any annuity from the government, nor a member of
	any board or commission of the government, nor a member of
	the immediate family of an employee of the government. As
	used in this Section, immediate family means a collective body of
	persons living together in one house under one head. "
