AN ACT TO AMEND §3111 OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO REQUIRE QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 Section 1. Legislative Intent. For the past several years, the 3 Department of Public Health and Social Services has been faced with a 4 myriad of issues that have affected the services it provides to our

community. Some of the factors can be attributed to the economic situation 1 that Guam has experienced. Other factors also include the many federal 2 mandates that have changed over the years. I Mina'Bente Siete Na 3 Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Department of Public Health and Social 4 Services must protect and promote the personal, community and 5 environmental health of our island through the exercise of skilled 6 leadership that can cooperatively work with the general public in health 7 policy development to provide these necessary services to those in our 8 9 community who are the most vulnerable. In order to achieve this, the Director of the Department of Public Health and Social Services must 10 possess the educational background and expertise to effectively perform 11 these duties. Therefore, it is the intent of I Mina'Bente Siete Na Liheslaturan 12 Guåhan to mandate qualifications for the Director of the Department of 13 Public Health and Social Services. 14

15 Section 2. §3111 of Article 1, Chapter 3 of Title 5, Guam Code
16 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

*"§3111. Department of Public Health and Social Services.*There is within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam a
Department of Public Health and Social Services, the head of which is
the Director. The Director of the Department of Public Health and
Social Services is appointed by *I Maga'lahi* with the advice and
consent of *I Liheslatura*. The Director shall meet the following
minimum qualifications:

a) Shall have graduated from a recognized college or university with a Master's Degree in Health Administration,

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healthcare service management, human service or a health related field, and five (5) years of experience in the management and administration of a human service, social service, or healthcare service organization of which three (3) years shall have been experienced as an administrator or director in human service, social service, or healthcare service organization; or

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b) Shall have graduated from a recognized college or university with a Master's Degree in Business Administration or Public Administration, and five (5) years of experience in health administration, human service, social service or healthcare service organization of which three (3) years must have been experienced as an administrator or director in a public health setting, human service, social service or healthcare service organization; or

Shall have graduated from a recognized college or 16 c) university with a Bachelor's Degree in Health Administration, 17 healthcare service management, human service or health 18 related field, and eight (8) years of experience in health 19 administration or healthcare related field, of which five (5) 20 years shall have been experienced as an administrator or 21 director in a public health, human service, social service or 22 healthcare service organization." 23

Section 3. New Appointment. Any new appointment of a Director
 after enactment of this Act shall be in compliance with the provisions of
 this Act.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
