

**AN ACT TO REQUIRE SIX (6) MONTHS
PERFORMANCE REVIEWS OF THE HEADS
OF ALL AGENCIES, INSTRUMENTALITIES
AND ENTITIES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Definitions.** For purposes of this Act only:

3 (i) Agency, instrumentality, or entity shall mean the
4 Department of Education, the Guam Power Authority,
5 the Guam Waterworks Authority, the Guam Telephone

1 Authority, the Guam Housing Corporation, the Guam
2 Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, the Public
3 Defender Service Corporation, the Jose D. Leon Guerrero
4 Commercial Port, the A.B. Won Pat Guam International
5 Airport Authority, the Guam Economic Development and
6 Commerce Authority, the Civil Service Commission, the
7 Department of Chamorro Affairs, the Chamorro Land
8 Trust Commission, the Ancestral Lands Commission, the
9 Guam Memorial Hospital Authority, the Guam
10 Educational Telecommunications Corporation, the Guam
11 Council of the Arts and Humanities, the Guam Visitors
12 Bureau, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, the
13 Guam Election Commission, and the Government of
14 Guam Retirement Fund.

15 (ii) Governing Board shall mean the Consolidated
16 Commission on Utilities, the Education Policy Board,
17 Board of Directors, council, commission, or board with
18 the statutory authority to select the chief executive of the
19 agency, instrumentality, or entity for which it determines
20 policy.

21 (iii) Chief Executive shall mean the Senior Manager who
22 heads an agency including, but not limited to, the
23 Director, Executive Director, General Manager, President,
24 Hospital Administrator, or Administrator.

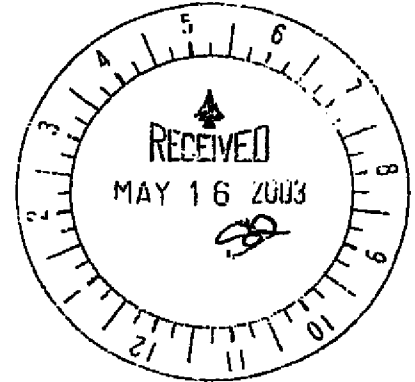
1 **Section 2. Performance Reviews of Agency Heads.** The
2 governing boards for all agencies, instrumentalities, or entities shall
3 issue performance reviews of the chief executive selected for that
4 agency, six (6) months after appointment of the said chief executive
5 and every six (6) months thereafter that the Chief Executive is
6 retained by the Governing Board. Each performance review shall
7 document the Chief Executive's performance, accomplishments, and
8 the respective Governing Board's reasons for retaining the said Chief
9 Executive.

10 **Section 3. Publication of Performance Reviews.** The
11 performance reviews required under this Act shall be made public
12 and the availability of these reviews shall be published by the
13 respective governing boards issuing the aforementioned reviews by
14 newspaper of general circulation or by radio or television which is
15 reasonably calculated to provide notice of the facts it announces to
16 the public at large.
