AN ACT TO REQUIRE SIX (6) MONTHS PERFORMANCE REVIEWS OF THE HEADS OF ALL AGENCIES, INSTRUMENTALITIES AND ENTITIES.

#### 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Definitions. For purposes of this Act only:
- 3 (i) Agency, instrumentality, or entity shall mean the 4 Department of Education, the Guam Power Authority, 5 the Guam Waterworks Authority, the Guam Telephone

Authority, the Guam Housing Corporation, the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, the Public Defender Service Corporation, the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port, the A.B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority, the Guam Economic Development and Commerce Authority, the Civil Service Commission, the Department of Chamorro Affairs, the Chamorro Land Trust Commission, the Ancestral Lands Commission, the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority, the Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation, the Guam Council of the Arts and Humanities, the Guam Visitors Bureau, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, the Guam Election Commission, and the Government of Guam Retirement Fund.

- (ii) Governing Board shall mean the Consolidated Commission on Utilities, the Education Policy Board, Board of Directors, council, commission, or board with the statutory authority to select the chief executive of the agency, instrumentality, or entity for which it determines policy.
- (iii) Chief Executive shall mean the Senior Manager who heads an agency including, but not limited to, the Director, Executive Director, General Manager, President, Hospital Administrator, or Administrator.

Section 2. Performance Reviews of Agency Heads. The governing boards for all agencies, instrumentalities, or entities shall issue performance reviews of the chief executive selected for that agency, six (6) months after appointment of the said chief executive and every six (6) months thereafter that the Chief Executive is retained by the Governing Board. Each performance review shall document the Chief Executive's performance, accomplishments, and the respective Governing Board's reasons for retaining the said Chief Executive.

Section 3. Publication of Performance Reviews. The performance reviews required under this Act shall be made public and the availability of these reviews shall be published by the respective governing boards issuing the aforementioned reviews by newspaper of general circulation or by radio or television which is reasonably calculated to provide notice of the facts it announces to the public at large.


