CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO I MAGA'LAHEN GUÅHAN

Public Law No. 27-34

MINA'BENTE SIETE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2003 (FIRST) Regular Session

Bill No. 83 (COR)

As substituted by the Committee on Appropriations and Budgeting, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, as further substituted on the Floor, and as amended on the Floor.

By request of I Maga'lahen Guåhan in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, as amended.

AN ACT TO FACILITATE REORGANIZATION AND PRIVATIZATION BY *AMENDING* §11102 OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, §1800 OF TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, AND BY *ADDING* A NEW §4207.1 TO TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan
- 3 finds that certain existing provisions of the Guam Code Annotated
- 4 governing "reorganization" of the government of Guam are restrictive
- 5 of the privatization and outsourcing mandates required by the current
- 6 financial and economic circumstances of the government of Guam.

1 Thus, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds it necessary to amend specific provisions that will facilitate implementation of such measures.

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Section 2. 5 GCA §11102 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"§11102. Employment Security. No classified employee at the time a reorganization plan is adopted shall be removed from his or her position or downgraded as a result of any reorganization undertaken pursuant to the plan, except pursuant to reduction in force procedures contained in 4 GCA §4207, Civil Service Commission Rules, and Public Law 27-05:IV:19."

Section 3. 1 GCA §1800 is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

Requirement of Approval by I Liheslatura for "§1800. Privatization. No office, department, agency, institution, board, bureau, commission, council, authority, committee of territorial government, branch, or the Guam Visitors Bureau, of the government of Guam may privatize any function or transfer any real property of the government of Guam without the approval of I Liheslatura. Any plan or action taken by an office, department, instrumentality, agency, institution, board, bureau, commission, council, authority, committee of territorial government, branch, or the Guam Visitors Bureau purporting to privatize any function or transfer any real property of the government of Guam shall be transmitted to I Liheslatura which, by statute, may amend. approve, or disapprove the plan or the action taken within fortyfive (45) days or said plan or action shall be deemed approved."

Section 4. A new §4207.1 is added to Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

"§4207.1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any reduction in force shall safeguard the health, safety, and education of the island and shall ensure maintenance of effort levels and sustainability of federally-funded programs at no less than current levels. *I Maga'lahi* or Directors shall certify to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* compliance with this Section."

Section 5. Severability. If any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall *not* affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
