Transmitted herewith is Bill No. 107 (COR), "AN ACT TO *AMEND* §15907 OF CHAPTER 15, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING AUTHONOMOUS AGENCIES TO PAY FOR PEDRO "DOC" SANCHEZ SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS FOR THEIR EMPLOYEES WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM," which I signed into law on December 17, 2003, as Public Law No. 27-53.

This measure provides continued assistance for government of Guam employees to obtain a higher education. The knowledge and skill acquired by the employees through the Doc Sanchez program and applied in the government sector will enhance government services. Furthermore, Bill No. 107 will provide some relief to the General Fund by requiring the autonomous agencies to pay for their employees who participate in the scholarship program.

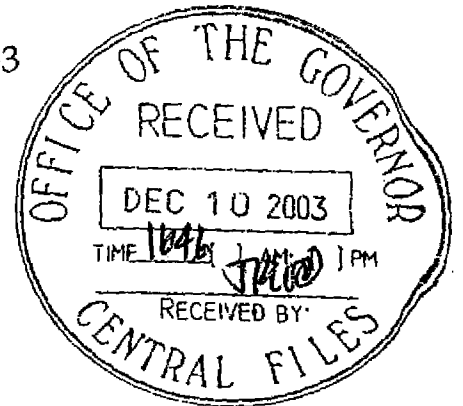





**AN ACT TO AMEND §15907 OF CHAPTER 15, TITLE 17,  
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING  
AUTONOMOUS AGENCIES TO PAY FOR PEDRO "DOC"  
SANCHEZ SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS FOR THEIR  
EMPLOYEES WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** §15907 of Chapter 15, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated,  
3 is hereby *amended* to read:

4 **"§15907. Funding for the Scholarship Program.**

5 (a) The University of Guam shall extend full support and  
6 complete assistance for the Pedro 'Doc' Sanchez Professional  
7 Scholarship for Career Employees of the government of Guam as

1 mandated by this Act by budgeting for scholarship funds to  
2 support scholarship grantees.

3 (b) Beginning with the academic year 2004-2005, all  
4 awards for participants of the scholarship program herein who are  
5 employed by autonomous agencies shall be paid for by their  
6 respective autonomous agencies as defined by Title 12 of the  
7 Guam Code Annotated, *except* for employees of the Guam  
8 Educational Telecommunications Corporation who shall continue  
9 to have their awards paid for through appropriation by *I*  
10 *Lihselaturan Guåhan.*"
