#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §8104 (a) (1) of 5 GCA, is amended to read:

"(a) (1) Public agency includes any board, commission or comparable unit of government, any of whose members are elected, appointed by *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* or appointed by *I Liheslatura*; any non-profit corporation created by one (1) or more public agencies or *I Liheslatura*, and whose board of directors is appointed by such public

agencies or by *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* or *I Liheslatura*, and which is formed to acquire, construct, reconstruct, maintain or operate any public work project, or any board, commission, committee or other body on which officers of a public agency serve in their official capacity as members and which is supported in whole or in part by funds provided by such agency, whether such board, commission, committee or other body is organized and operated by such local agency or by a private corporation."

#### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Appropriations and Budgeting, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform to which was referred Bill 233 (COR) held a public hearing at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 12, 2004 in the Public Hearing Room, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. A paid ad was publicized in the Pacific Daily News on Wednesday, March 24 and Wednesday, May 5, 2004. The hearing was also announced Thursday, May 6, and Monday, May 10 in discussion on News Talk K57 during "The Big Show" with Travis Coffman; Tuesday, May 11, 2004 during News Talk K57 news broadcasts and in a news brief on KUAM news; and Wednesday, May 12, 2004 in a news article in the Pacific Daily News.

#### Senators present at the public hearing were:

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

**Jacob Cruz**, representing himself stated that he is in support of Bill 233.

David .R. Craddick, General Manager of Guam Waterworks, who was not able to provide an oral testimony submitted a written testimony, which stated that the Consolidated Commission on Utilities is currently complying with the Open Government Law and is therefore in support of Bill 233. (See attachment 1).

**Juan P. Flores, Superintendent of Education,** provided a written testimony in support of the intent of Bill 233. (See attachment 2).

Rosa Palomo, Vice Chair of the Guam Educational Policy Board, stated a brief oral testimony that she too, is in support of the bill.

#### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Appropriations and Budgeting, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform finds that Bill No. 233 is a good measure to instill the accountability within the Government of Guam as to where all board and Commission members can be a part of the Open Government Law.

Accordingly, the Committee on Appropriations and Budgeting, General Governmental Operations, Reorganization and Reform, to which Bill No 233 was referred, does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to *I Mina Bente Siete Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* TO DO PASS BILL NO. 233 (COR) - An Act Relative To 5 GCA §8104 (A) (1) To Make The Open Government Law Applicable To Elected Boards And Commissions.

Bill 188: An act relative to appropriating the sum of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) from the Fiscal Year 2004 General Fund derived from the recent bank tax settlement to address educational facility repair requirements, tax refund payments and other necessary expenses of the Government of Guam.

Bill 201: An act to utilize a portion of the recent tax settlement to offset the recently re-imposed 11.5% rate surcharge by appropriating the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) from the General Fund to GWA to provide GWA with funding for emergency procurement for repairs to the Ugum Water Treatment Plant and to place a temporary moratorium on all new surcharges and rate increases by GWA.
